- [Jane Smith died in her sleep, and had a B.A. in Art from Trinity University. Lamar was in Washington at the time, being sworn in to his third term.](#)
- We need to find a NJ resident to go to the Mercer County courthouse to find their marriage certificate and any property deeds.
- We cannot get a death certificate for Jane Smith, as it is a protected record until 2016.

Mysterious Documents:

- Lamar S. Smith [did something](#) with \$120,000, possibly in Kentucky, with Jane Smith in 1988. Did he buy a house? Loan a bank some money?

- Ties to alcohol and gambling industries revealed here, too
- [Individuals who donated to Longhorn](#) (LOTS of lobbyists, also Steve Ballmer, and the famous Charrisse Kaplan, and Fox News execs such as Murdoch)
 - Kaplan has given \$60,000 to politicians as a “Homemaker” since 1999

 - Apple employee Joshua Tenuta donated \$500 (generally perceived as a liberal company)
- [Contributions from Longhorn](#)
 - Need to check to see if any of these are Democrats
 - Has supported Mitt Romney in last two elections, even when Rick Perry (a Texan) was running. Donated \$5k to Romney once in 2007 and again on 05/18/2011.
 - He gave free consulting to Michael Sodrel, and also donated \$1073 worth of catering on the same day. Ironically, he also valued his consulting fees for Sodrel as \$1073 (the same price as the food....) Shifty book-keeping?
