articulation	the clarity of a speaker's words and ideas	
crescendo	rise in volume and pace during a speech

inflection	accentuating particular words or parts of words for effect	
organization	a meaningful order or structure of a presentation, determined by topic and audience	
purpose	the reason for the presentation, beyond "because it was assigned to me"
