Scenarios

If you were asked to.....	Would you?	What would you need to do?
Give a 3 year old child a special milk-oat/soy/lactose free (not an allergy, perhaps an intolerance)		
Dissolve a tablet in orange juice to encourage a child to take it		
Apply teething gel		
Administer nebulised medication		
Allow a six year old to carry and manage their own asthma reliever medication		
Administer asthma reliever medication to a child previously unknown to have asthma		
Supervise a child with ADHD medication (you think the dose is too high?)		
Administer adrenaline via syringe as parent cannot afford an epi-pen		
Give asthma reliever medication as needed		
Provide pain relief medication (paracetamol) to an older child for self-reported pain		
Apply nappy cream		
Provide jelly beans for a child with diabetes		
Treat a child for head lice		
A parent hands you a Seizure Management Plan and requires Intra-nasal Midazolam.		
Provide a copy of the medication log to a child's doctor		
Advise a parent if their child's medication is helping their behaviour
