Kindergarten

1. A backpack. Please choose one that is large enough to hold a school folder and library books. Do not choose a backpack with wheels. Please have your child's name written in their backpack.
2. A snack bag that can be separated from your backpack. Please have your child's name on their snack bag.
3. A thermos bottle with a sports cap (Push/ Pull). Please have your child's name on their thermos bottle. Please have your child practice using their water bottle.
4. 8 containers of PlayDoh to donate to the class.
5. 5 black, erasable, low odor white board markers to donate to the class.

1st Grade

3rd Grade

- 4 folders (One of each color: red, yellow, green and blue) Our folders will be color-coded according to subject area. Please make sure that your folders match the colors we will be using.
- 4 Hard-Cover Composition Notebook (preferably not spiral bound – those tend to bend out of shape within our desks)
- 1 Art Smock – (should be inside of a large Ziploc bag – bag should be labeled with name) Make sure your name is on your art smock and it is cleaned and ready to go for this year. Large or extra-large t-shirts work best!

- 1 Set of headphones for your child to use while working with technology. Please put these in a bag/container and label with your child's name.
- 1 Plastic or hard sided pencil/supply box
- 4 or more Glue sticks
- 4 Fine-tip expo dry erase board markers. We use whiteboards often and markers are needed for your child's use. If you are unable to provide any of the above supplies, we will have extra available for students. Please let the classroom teacher know if any of the supplies are needed for your child.

2	1 - 1 ½ inch Binders with pockets (1 pocket in front, 1 pocket in back) *One will be used for Mrs. Knowles' class and one for Mrs. Westermann's class.

1	Personal pencil sharpener
