### **Opening Prayer Prompts For Group:**

**P-Praise** Him that His judgments are righteous and good.

**R- Repent** by confessing any ways you have **ignored Christ's authority in your life.**

**A-Ask** God for opportunities to share the gospel with people.

**Y-Yield** by asking God to help you live with **hope, courage, and faithfulness.**

**Ice Breaker:** When you hear the phrase "Jesus is coming back," what is your initial reaction? Why?

### **The Sermon Setup: Revelation 19:11-20:15**

- Read Revelation 19:1-8 The word "**Hallelujah**" appears four times in this passage. What are some of the things the people are praising God so passionately about in the text?
  - What does it say about God that **His judgments are "true and righteous?"**
- Read Revelation 19:11-16. Why is it that those who accompany Christ do no fighting? What is the significance of the sword being in his mouth rather than in his hand?
  - What does this picture of him tell us about **the power of Christ?**
- Read Revelation 19:17-21. Why is it significant that there is no real battle?

### **Going Deeper**

- Read Revelation 20:11-15. Many people struggle with the idea of God judging people. Why does judgment feel uncomfortable for us today?
  - How might the **persecuted churches of Revelation** have felt about this moment? How can it encourage us today?
- Read 2 Peter 3:9, 1 Timothy 2:3-4, Ezekiel 33:11. What do these verses reveal about **God's desire for people?**
  - How do these verses help us understand **why Jesus came?**
