**Approval of September 2025 General Membership Meeting Minutes:** Minutes were approved.

### **Membership Update:**

### **Guest Speakers:**

**Maudie with CG and S Design-Build passed out surveys to survey members regarding questions they may have and help they might need for renovations. This is in preparation for a presentation in March by CG and S.**

**The possible new owner of St. Lukes Church spoke about the plans for the property. He hopes to redevelop the sanctuary and front portion of the property into a bookstore and coffee/wine bar along with a possible art gallery that needs to relocate. The back portion of the property will remain undeveloped and possibly sold at a later date for single family housing. Questions about safety on 14th Street was brought up and the possibility of parking only on one side of the street was brought up as a possible answer.**

**Bobby Levinski from SOS updated the membership on the plans for expansion of South MoPac from Slaughter Lane to Cesar Chavez. There are numerous concerns regarding the addition of more lanes in this corridor including the expansion to 13 lanes over Lady Bird**

**Lake. He stated that the eventual plan is to connect SW 45 to MoPac South greatly increasing the traffic on the freeway. He is asking neighborhood associations to come together to oppose the current timeline so that an environmental impact study can be completed to more effectively fight the current expansion plan. #### **Zoning**

**Donna Osborn encouraged all to read the updates provided before the meeting. The biggest update was members of the zoning committee met with representatives of Millennium who are developing the YMCA project the day before. There is a traffic impact study being done and this will be shared with OWANA.**

#### **Parks**

**Chris Schorre gave an update on West Austin Park. He said the water quality project for the park is scheduled to start in August, 2027. Permitting was filed before fees increased. The project is still waiting for approval of the parks agreement before new bids can be sought.**

#### **Events**

**On December 4th, proceeds from Galaxy will go to Mathews Elementary. Peace Through Pie happens on January 17th at Sweet Home Baptist Church.**

#### **Misc Items:**

**Kathy Tovo, currently running for Texas House District 49, Josh Reyna also running for State Representative for District 49 and Rich Heyman running for City Council, District 9 all introduced themselves.**

**William Osborn gave an update on safety concerns in the neighborhood specifically about the house at 8th and Blanco where a bike thief was recently arrested, lived. The plan is to file a suit against the owners on a public nuisance charge so that perhaps prospective buyer would apply pressure on the buyer to clean up the property.**

**Steve Amos ended with a few goals for 2026 that included continue efforts to engage with**

**neighbors, grow the membership, support Kirk Watson's atx initiative, work with AIA on their Community by Design and foster more community engagement.**
