HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION

It is the policy of the Deer Isle-Stonington CSD 13 School Board that each student enrolled in the Deer Isle-Stonington High School shall earn a high school diploma, as defined in the Graduation Requirements Policy. The Board recognizes that implementation of this policy necessitates individually supportive, student-centered strategies and that this represents a challenge that will require perseverance on the part of the School Board, administration and staff. Furthermore, the Board supports initiatives that provide educational programs and assistance to support the needs of students in meeting the graduation requirements of Deer Isle-Stonington High School. Whenever possible, school staff shall recruit dropouts back into school to earn a high school diploma.
