

Emergency Response and Wildfire Preparedness Team: The team will be responsible for preparing our community for wildfires and educating residents about lowering the fire risk in our neighborhood. The team will also plan evacuation procedures and relay the plan to Ondulando Residents with the help of Police and Fire Departments.

This team is also for those residents who would like to take a role during emergencies. This team will focus on ensuring all our neighbors are notified of an emergency by, for example, knocking on doors or using a phone tree to alert neighbors. If you are interested, you can also get training through the CERT or Community Emergency Response Training and be able to work with fire and police during an emergency. CERT is online and in person classes.

Communications Team: The team will recruit and use expertise of Ondulando residents to build and maintain a website, a dedicated email address, and an online presence on social media, including Facebook and NextDoor Ondulando. Team will also recruit a resident with knowledge about Public Relations for events and maintaining a database for tracking hours and fuel reduction for annual renewal requiring at least 640 hours.

Community Outreach Team: The team will provide continuity for our Firewise Community by tracking new residents who have recently moved to Ondulando and giving them information about Firewise Community and welcoming them.

Water Assurance and Local Government Liaison Team: The team will work with city government to provide transparency on water availability for wildfires and other emergencies, and to assure residents that the water pumping emergency generators are serviced on a continual basis. The team will also work with Fire Departments, Police Departments, Water Department, and utilities SCE and SoCal Gas to understand the emergency contingencies.
