"Lady"





Sizes: S(M,L,XL)

Supplies: 4mm (UK: 8, US: 6) Straight needles, 3.25mm (UK: 10,US: 3) circular needles for neckband, 4 Stitch holders.

Yarn: 8 ply black, (Small: 350g-400g, Medium: 400g-450g, Large: 450g-500g, Extra Large: 500g-550g) 8 ply white 50g

Notes

- This jumper is worked into four parts and sewn up with mattress stitch.
- Rib for both jumper and beanie is the twisted knit. To create the twisted knit, you go into the back loop instead of putting the needle in the front. If you prefer the normal knit, by all means do so, I just used the twisted knit because the ribbing looked tidy compared to normal knit.
- The cat is worked in white and the rest of the sts is worked in black knitted or purled, depending on the row.

Front

Cast on 91 (103, 111, 123)

Row 1: K1,P1 (RS)

Row 2:P1,K1 (WS)

Continue repeating row 1 and 2 for 10 rows total, making sure you end on an even row. We will continue in stockinette for the remainder.

Knit one row (RS) and purl one row (WS)

Cat silhouette

The cat silhouette is 26 rows in height and 11 sts in length

Knit 18 st, start on the diagram. Diagrams is made side to side.Refer to notes.

After you have done the cat silhouette, continue in the stockinette for 28 more rows.

Shaping raglan armholes

Cast off 2 (2, 4, 6) sts...87 (99, 103, 111)

1st row: (RS) k3, sl 1, k1, psso, k to last 5 st, k2tog, k3...85(97, 101, 109)

2nd row: purl

3rd row: knit

4th row: purl

Size small only- Repeat row 1 to 4 3 more times....79 sts

tillics..../3 Sts

All sizes-

1st row: k3, sl 1, k1, psso, k to last 5 st, k2tog, k3...77(95, 99, 107)

2nd row: purl

Repeat **1st** and **2nd** row until there are 61(65, 67, 73) sts left on the needle, working last row on WS.

126×11-7

Shape neck

1st row: k3, sl 1, k1, psso,k 16(18, 18, 20), turn,

Continue on these 20(22, 22, 24) sts for left side of neck,

Dec one st at raglan edge (inside 3st as before) in every following alternate row 7 times, DEC one st at neck edge at the same time 7 times...6 sts.

Next row: (WS) purl

Next row: (RS) k3, sl 1,k1, psso, k1.....5sts **Next row: (WS)** purl

Next row: (RS) k3, sl 1, k1, psso...4sts Next row: (WS) purl

Next row: (RS) K2tog, sl 1, k1, psso....3sts Next row: (WS) purl

Next row:(RS) k1, sl 1, k1, psso...2sts Next row:(WS) k2tog..fasten off

Slip next 19 (19, 21, 23) sts onto a stitch holder and leave for the neckband. With right side facing, join yarn to remaining sts at neck edge, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3. Continue on these 20(22, 22, 24) sts for the right side of the neck.

Dec 1 st at raglan edge(inside the 3sts as before) in every following alternate row 7 times, at the same time dec one at neck edge 7 times...6 sts

Next row: (WS) Purl

Next row: (RS) k1, k2tog, k3..5sts Next row:(WS) purl

Next row:(RS) k2tog, k3.....4sts Next row:(WS) purl

Next row: (RS) k2tog,k2....3sts Next row: (WS) purl

Next row:(RS) k2tog, k2....2sts **Next row:(WS)** k2tog..fasten off

Back

Cast on 91 (103,111,123) with 4mm (UK 8, US 6) needles

Repeat the same ribbing pattern as <u>front</u>.

Work 56 rows Stockinette, making sure that odd rows are knit and even rows are purl, last rows ends on purl.

Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 2(2,4,6) sts at the beginning of the next two rows...87(99,103,111)

1st row: **(RS)** k3, sl 1, k1, psso, k to last 5 sts, k2tog,k3...85(97,101,109)sts

2nd row: purl

3rd row: knit

4th row: purl

Small size only- repeat rows **1-4** 3 more times..79 sts

All sizes-

1st row:(RS) k3, sl 1, k1, psso, k to last 5sts, k2tog, k3 ...77(95,99,107)

2nd row: (WS) Purl

Repeat these two rows until there are 37(39,41,45) left, working the last row on **WS**, Leave the remaining sts on a stitch holder for the neckband.

Sleeves

Cast on 45 (47, 47, 49) with 4mm (UK 8, US 6) needles.

Row 1 : **(RS)** k1, p1

Row 2: (WS) p1,k1

Worked wrist up.

Continue these rows until there are a total of <u>20</u> ribbing rows worked, making sure you end on an even row.

Inc at the beginning and end of the next row, then in every following 14th (10th, 6th, 6th) row until you have 57 (67, 51, 77) sts on the needle.

Then inc in every 16th (12th, 8th, 8th) row until we have 61 (69, 75, 83) sts on the needle.

The sleeve should measure around 48cm at this point, making sure the last row you did was on the WS.

Shaping

Cast of 2(2, 4, 6) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows...57(65, 67, 71)

1st row: (RS) k3, sl 1, k1, psso, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3...55(63, 65, 69)

2nd row:purl

3rd row: knit

4th row: purl

Repeat rows **1 to 4** 4 (2, 2, 2) times...47(59, 61, 65)

Repeat rows **1st** and **2nd** row until there are 9 sts left, making sure the last row is worked on the **WS**. Leave remaining 9 sts on a stitch holder for the neckband.

Neckband

Using mattress st, join raglan seams together (this is not including the 9 sts of sleeves, as those stitches are used for part of the neckline)

Using 3.25mm (Uk 10, US 3) circular needles, knit across 9 sts from the <u>left</u> sleeve stitch holder. Make sure you start on the left side or the neckland will not come out properly.

Dec 2 sts at beginning and end of the 9sts. Knit up 22(24, 24, 25) sts evenly across the <u>left</u> side of the neck.

Knit 19 (19, 21, 23) sts from <u>front</u> stitch holder, dec at beginning and end of the 19 (19, 21, 23) sts. Knit up 22 (24, 24 25) sts evenly across the <u>right</u> side of neck.

Knit across the 9 sts from the <u>right</u> side sleeve, dec 2 sts at beginning and end of the 9 sts. Then knit across the 37(39, 41, 43) sts left on the stitch holder at the <u>back</u>, dec 5 sts evenly across... 107(113, 117, 123)

1st Row: k1,p1, work a further 5 rows rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

Using mattress st, join seams.

Beanie

Supplies: 4mm(UK 8, US 6) circular needles (40cm), stitch marker.

3.75mm (UK 9, US 5) or 4.00mm (UK 8, US 6) 5 double pointed needles

Yarn: 100g black and 50g white(for both child/adult small and adult large)

Notes

• The knits in the ribbing is also done with the twisted knit, where you insert the needle in the back loop instead of the front. You don't have to do the twisted knit, but I prefer doing it because to me it makes the ribbing look neater.

Ribbing

Cast on 92(100)sts

1st row: k2 p2

Continue ribbing for a total of 10 rows.

Cat silhouette

For the beanie, I took away some rows. So the cat silhouette just for the beanie is 23 in height and 11 in length

Knit 18 st and start the cat, see diagram, is made in round. The Crosses are the rows i took out.


Continue stockinette until 7 inches (8 inches)

Decrease

Next row: knit 23(25)st on 4 dpns Next row: k1, k2tog

Next row: k2tog

Next row: knit **Next row:** k2tog



Use a tapestry needle and weave the sts. Weave in all ends.
