1. Incentives Saved ([Endpoint](#))
 - a. Hathor created an endpoint that shows net incentives saved by the algorithm.
 - b. Methodology:
 - i. Uses Epoch 813, the last epoch before our first incentive adjustment, as a reference point.
 - ii. Compares daily internal incentives to incentives spent on epoch 813.
 - iii. Does not count the 9893.003994 Osmos/Day saved by [Proposal 638](#).
 1. This is from Epoch 841 onward.
 - iv. The thirdening doesn't necessarily count as reducing incentives. Depends on how much of the existing LP Emissions actually go to pools.
