

Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us at Hyve House LLC. Hyve House LLC, a Texas limited liability company, for itself and on behalf of its subsidiaries (collectively, "Company", "we", "our", or "us") established this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") which describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information when You use (a) www.thehyvehouse.com, our software as a service or other technology platform, and any of our related websites, applications, services, and our downloadable mobile or desktop application(s) (collectively, "the Site") or (b) our services accessible through the Site ("Services"), including without limitation the information gathered from any email, text, and other electronic messages through the site, and tells You about Your privacy rights and how the law protects You.

We use Your Personal data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy may change from time to time. If you choose to use or access our Site or Services after we make changes to our Privacy Policy, your use or access will be deemed an acceptance of those changes, so please check the Privacy Policy periodically for updates.

If you are a resident of California, Colorado, Connecticut, Utah and Virginia, you may be afforded additional rights under these state's laws. Please see the sections below entitled, "Your California Privacy Rights" and "Additional Information for Colorado, Connecticut, Virginia, and Utah Residents," below for more information on such rights and how to exercise such rights.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

Account means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of our Service.

Affiliate means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.

Application refers to Hyve, the software program provided by the Company.

Company (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Hyve House LLC, 5900 Balcones Drive Ste 100 Austin, TX 78731.

Cookies are small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing the details of Your browsing history on that website among its many uses.

Country refers to: United States

Device means any device that can access the Service such as a computer, a cellphone or a digital tablet.

Personal Data is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.

Service refers to the Application or the Website or both.

Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of the Company, to perform services related to the Service or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is used.

Usage Data refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

You means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using Our Service, We may ask You to provide Us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify You. If You use or access certain portions of our Site, or certain Services, we may require you to provide contact and identity information, billing information, and other Personal Information as indicated on forms throughout our Site. Where possible, we indicate the fields you must complete to use our Site or Services and those fields that are optional. You always have the option not to provide your information by choosing not to use, access, or purchase one or more of our Services, or access certain portions of our Site. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number
- Address, State, Province, ZIP/Postal code, City

- Usage Data

Additionally we may collect any personal information You provide us in communications you send or provide when you telephone our office, send Us a text message, or interact with any communications tools on our Site.

The information above is collected and stored electronically when you use or access our Site, purchase our Services, request a demo of our Services or sign up for a free trial, create an account with Us, sign up to receive newsletters and/or marketing communications, sign up for Our webinars/events/forums, or contact Us. We collect this information directly from you when you provide it to us through your access to or usage of our Site or Services and automatically as you navigate through our Site and Services. Information collected automatically may include usage details.

Under some circumstances we may require some additional financial information. We use your financial information, including credit card information, to verify the accuracy of your name, address, and other information, as well as to bill you for your use of our Services.

Information Collected Automatically

Information about your computer hardware and software may automatically be collected by the Company when you use the Site or Services. This information may include:

- IP address

- Browser Type

- Type of operating system

- Device Type

- Unique device identifier

- Internet service provider

- Language preference

- Access times and dates

- Geographic location

- Referring website addresses

- Browsing history

- Search queries

- Transaction details

- Location

- Other technical information such as protocol status and substatus, bytes sent and received, and server information

This information is used by Us for Our business purposes, including without limitation for the operation and improvement of the Site, for technical troubleshooting, to maintain quality of the Site and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Site.

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service.

Usage Data may include information such as Your Device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that You visit, the time and date of Your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When You access the Service by or through a mobile device, We may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device You use, Your mobile device unique ID, the IP address of Your mobile device, Your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser You use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that Your browser sends whenever You visit our Service or when You access the Service by or through a mobile device.

Information Collected while Using the Application

While using Our Application, in order to provide features of Our Application, We may collect, with Your prior permission:

Information regarding your location

Pictures and other information from your Device's camera and photo library

We use this information to provide features of Our Service, to improve and customize Our Service. The information may be uploaded to the Company's servers and/or a Service Provider's server or it may be simply stored on Your device.

You can enable or disable access to this information at any time, through Your Device settings.

Location Data Usage

Our app accesses your location data only when specific features, such as event creation and event check-ins, are used. You may also choose to allow the app to access your location in the background to facilitate location-based check-ins even when the app is not actively in use. This location data is not shared with any third parties, nor is it used for analytics, personalized content, or targeted advertising.

Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use Cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on Our Service and store certain information. Tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze Our Service. The technologies We use may include:

- **Cookies or Browser Cookies.** A cookie is a small file placed on Your Device. You can instruct Your browser to refuse all Cookies or to indicate when a Cookie is being sent. However, if You do not accept Cookies, You may not be able to use some parts of our Service. Unless you have adjusted Your browser setting so that it will refuse Cookies, our Service may use Cookies.
- **Web Beacons.** Certain sections of our Service and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of a certain section and verifying system and server integrity).

- **Persistent Cookies.** Persistent Cookies are used for a number of reasons, such as storing your preferences and retrieving certain information You have previously provided. Persistent Cookies are stored on your devices after You exit your browser.

Throughout the Company's Privacy Policy, We can use the term "Cookies" to include Browser Cookies, Flash Cookies, Web Beacons, Session Cookies, and Persistent Cookies.. Persistent Cookies remain on Your personal computer or mobile device when You go offline, while Session Cookies are deleted as soon as You close Your web browser.

The information from Cookies is also stored in web server logs, which are then transmitted back to the Company by your computers or mobile devices. These servers and Cookies are operated and managed by Us and/or Our service providers. As You use the Site and Services, your browser communicates with servers operated by the Company and/or Our service providers to coordinate and record interactivity and fill your requests for services and information.

We use Cookies for the purposes set out below:

Necessary / Essential Cookies

Purpose: These Cookies are essential to provide You with services available through the Website and to enable You to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these Cookies, the services that You have asked for cannot be provided, and We only use these Cookies to provide You with those services.

Cookies Policy / Notice Acceptance Cookies

Purpose: These Cookies identify if users have accepted the use of cookies on the Website.

Functionality Cookies

Purpose: These Cookies allow us to remember choices You make when You use the Website, such as remembering your login details or language preference. The purpose of these Cookies is to provide You with a more personal experience and to avoid You having to re-enter your preferences every time You use the Website.

Preferences Cookies

Purpose: These cookies collect information about how you have used the Site in the past and allow the Site to remember the choices you have made. These cookies allow us to improve how the Site works for you and tailor the Site to your preferences.

Analytics Cookies

Purpose: These cookies collect information about how you use the Site, such as which pages you most often visit on the Site, the time you spend on the Site, which links you click on, and any issues encountered. These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the Site. All information collected is aggregated and does not identify you.

Marketing Cookies

These cookies track your online activity to help deliver advertisements that are relevant to you and your interests and measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaigns. They

also limit how many times You can see a certain advertisement. We may share this information collected through these cookies with others, such as advertisers.

Cookies help us improve the Site by providing Us with information about which parts of the Site are most popular, what actions are taken by users and what content is viewed, enabling us to analyze technical and navigational information about the Site, and helping Us to detect and prevent fraud. We also use Cookies and other data collection tools (such as web beacons, pixels and embedded scripts) to help improve your experience with the Site. For example, we use Google Analytics to help analyze how users use the Site. These tools use Cookies to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information in an anonymous form. The information generated by the Cookie about your use of the Site (including IP address) is transmitted to our data collection tool service providers. This information is then used by us to evaluate visitors' use of the Site and to compile statistical reports on website activity for the Company. Company does not share your personal information with third parties for those parties' direct marketing purposes.

Your Rights and Choices

Retention of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain Your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use Your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to

improve the functionality of Our Service, or We are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those from Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer.
