



Reckoning Together COVID Policy

Reconstructing Judaism requires all participants to be vaccinated for COVID-19. Please bring your proof of vaccination with you. If you are unable to be vaccinated for medical reasons, you may apply for an exemption from Reconstructing Judaism's vaccine requirement. Exemptions will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

You are asked to take a self-administered rapid COVID-19 test before boarding your flight and to stay home if you test positive. On Friday and Saturday morning you will be required to take a rapid test and to confirm a negative result. Tests will be provided. If you develop any COVID-19 symptoms on the trip, you will be asked to isolate and take another rapid test, which we will have available.

Efforts will be made to provide outdoor seating at all meals. Most of the sites we will visit will not have mandatory mask policies. We will follow the requirements of all the places we visit. On the bus and in other indoor settings we encourage masking as a best practice for preventing transmission. We will do our best to provide good airflow and ventilation.

We will continue to monitor the science and community health recommendations around COVID-19 and adjust our policy if needed.
