

agileKRC Announces Launch of agilekrc.xyz in London in November 2025, Providing Organisations with Pragmatic Agile Consulting, Coaching, and Accredited Training Access

agileKRC has announced the launch of agilekrc.xyz in London, bringing a focused point of entry to pragmatic Agile consulting, coaching, and accredited training designed for real-world delivery. The

site brings proven Agile advice and training into one place so organisations can move from discussion to application without adopting prescriptive models that do not fit.” The statement aligns with a market preference for pragmatic frameworks that blend iterative delivery with existing governance, assurance, and portfolio practices.

The new site, accessible at agilekrc.xyz, offers an overview of consulting and coaching options alongside accredited training pathways, enabling decision-makers to evaluate formats that suit specific delivery environments. For organisations comparing approaches or seeking neutral orientation, the homepage provides context on balancing iterative practices with established controls. This soft entry aligns with the organisation’s long-standing position that Agile adoption should be shaped by context rather than ideology. The combined resources are intended to streamline early research and reduce inertia between interest, evaluation, and initial engagement.

The launch also reflects continuity in agileKRC’s stance that Agile achieves the best results when integrated with existing best practices, not when imposed as a universal template. “Many teams need Agile that fits their governance and risk profile, not a wholesale replacement of what already works,” said Jay Gao, Operations Manager at agileKRC. “Our approach has always been to listen first, then tailor.” The organisation’s training credentials include recognition as a Leader for Agile Project Management training in multiple Trusted Training Radar reports, with public courses noted for quality of instruction. Independent guidance from public sector

authorities has emphasised proportionate, iterative delivery governed by clear accountability, mirroring the site's emphasis on balance. Together, the new portal at agilekrc.xyz and the broader information at agilekrc.com present a route for teams to pursue Agile without discarding necessary controls.

The introduction of a single access point for services and training may influence how organisations plan capability uplift in 2026, particularly where L&D and PMO functions coordinate enterprise-wide standards. Consolidated discovery reduces duplicated effort and can shorten the interval between identifying a delivery constraint and testing a targeted intervention. If adoption follows current demand patterns, the site could support a gradual normalisation of hybrid Agile practices that combine iterative planning with portfolio-level oversight, auditability, and risk management. This may be most visible in large programmes where phased governance must coexist with rapid feedback cycles. Over time, more consistent exposure to pragmatic Agile approaches could moderate polarised debates between purity and practicality, with delivery performance and learning outcomes shaping the centre of gravity. The likely consequence is quieter transformation marked by measurable outcomes rather than headline claims.
