

Queer ASL Payment & Transfer Policy

Course Payment

In order to register for a Queer ASL class, you agree to pay an amount that falls within our payment sliding scale of \$100 - \$400 (in your currency) per level. You are expected to send your full payment right after. If you are unable to pay right away, you agree to send a deposit right away (\$20 minimum) and then pay the remaining amount as soon as possible. The deadline is two weeks before your class starts but we very much prefer that you complete your payment as soon as possible

Payment Methods:

- For folks who live within Canada, please send your payment via e-transfer to queerasl@gmail.com and include your registration name in the note section.
- For folks who live outside of Canada and have Paypal, please send your payment (in your currency) via this link: https://paypal.me/QueerASL?country.x=CA&locale.x=en_US and include your registration name in the note section.

Payment Plan

If absolutely necessary - you can do a payment plan and send a deposit (\$20 minimum) and complete your full payment two weeks before your course starts. You agree to email us right after registering with your payment plan information (how many payments, how often, and the payment dates). If you need a longer payment plan, please reach out to discuss with us.

Refunds

In order to get a refund, you need to let us know two weeks before your class starts to get a refund. If you register in less than two weeks before your class starts, your payment is un-refundable.

Deferring to Future Cycle:

You need to let us know two weeks before your class starts to successfully transfer your payment to the next or a future cycle. If you need to cancel after the two week deadline starts, it will be too late to defer your payment.

Cannot Pay:

If you cannot afford the minimum payment and need to pay less or none, please enter the amount you can afford and we will move you to a waiting list and reach out at the end of the registration cycle to offer you any remaining seats.
