Harris 301 Conference Room: Directions for Use

General Directions

- 1. Press the **Crestron** touch screen on the tabletop to activate it. If the screen is folded into the table, press firmly on the rear edge to tip it up to view.
- 2. Press the raised **Sources** button to the left of the touch screen. Choose your source:

DVD/VCR AuxPC

Aux Video Table Laptop (VGA)

- 3. The Plasma TV Display will automatically turn on (green light) once you have made a selection. (If it does not turn on, press up on the Power button, located beneath the bottom left corner of the Display)
- 4. All audio is played out via the portable speaker on the a/v cabinet.
 - Turn the portable speaker on by pressing the **Power On** button on the back of the speaker.
 - Attach the audio cable to the headphone jack of your laptop.
 - Control the volume by adjusting the Volume knob on the front of the speaker.
- 5. The **Enviro** button controls, on the touch screen, can be used to manually control the plasma screen, However ... Always use the **Sources** button for initial startup and the **Exit** button for final shutdown.

To view a laptop computer (HDMI)

- 1. Attach the HDMI cable, attached to the Plasma TV Display, to your laptop.
- 2. Select a Source i.e. DVD/VCR, on the touch screen, to turn on the Plasma TV Display.
- 3. Press up on the **Input** button (located beneath the bottom left corner of the Display) until **Input 2B** appears on the Screen.
- 4. Turn on your laptop computer. The image should appear on the screen.
- 5. If you wish to hear audio, attach the 1/2" stereo cable from the portable speaker to your laptop's headphone jack.

To view a laptop computer (VGA)

- 1. Attach the VGA cable, located below the touch screen, to your Laptop.
- 2. If you wish to hear audio, attach the \(\frac{1}{6} \) stereo cable from the portable speaker to your laptop's headphone jack.
- 3. Press **Table Laptop** video source on the touch screen.
- 5. Turn on the laptop computer.

To view a laptop computer (Aux PC (VGA) jack inside the A/V cabinet)

- 1. Attach a VGA cable to your laptop and to the **Aux PC** jack inside the A/V cabinet.
- 2. If you wish to hear audio, attach the \(\frac{1}{6} \) stereo cable from the portable speaker to your laptop's headphone jack.
- 3. Press **Aux PC** video source on the touch screen.
- 4. Turn on the laptop computer.

To view the DVD/VCR player (Out of Order)

Final Shutdown

- 1. Coil all cables up off the floor, to prevent damage.
- 2. Always shut the Crestron system down completely. If you do not, you will cause problems for the next user.

To shut the Crestron system down

- 1. Press the raised **Exit** button to the right of the touch screen.
- 2. "Are you sure you want to exit and shut the system down?" Press Yes.
- 3. The Plasma screen will cool down and shut off automatically.
