



## **T.E.A.C.H. Program – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

### **1. What is the T.E.A.C.H. Program?**

T.E.A.C.H. (Technology Energizing Aging Christians at Home) is an 8-week initiative designed to help senior adults gain confidence using iPads and digital tools, supported by Volunteer Tech Assistants.

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### **2. Who can participate?**

- **Seniors (ages 65+)** looking to learn technology skills
  - **Volunteer Tech Assistants (ages 14 & up)** willing to assist seniors during sessions
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### **3. What will seniors learn?**

- How to use iPads

- FaceTime, Zoom, email, and social media basics
  - Online safety and security tips
  - How to access faith-based resources online
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#### **4. What is the role of Volunteer Tech Assistants?**

Volunteers will provide one-on-one support to seniors, assist with technology questions, and help create a welcoming learning environment.

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#### **5. How long is the program, and when does it start?**

The program runs for **8 weeks** with **weekly 2-hour sessions** starting **September 6, 2025**.

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#### **6. Where will sessions be held?**

**At The Place UMC – Family Life Center.**

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#### **7. Is there a cost to participate?**

No, the program is free for both seniors and Volunteer Tech Assistants.
