1. What is the T.E.A.C.H. Program?

T.E.A.C.H. (Technology Energizing Aging Christians at Home) is an 8-week initiative designed to help senior adults gain confidence using iPads and digital tools, supported by Volunteer Tech Assistants.

2. Who can participate?

- Seniors (ages 65+) looking to learn technology skills
- Volunteer Tech Assistants (ages 14 & up) willing to assist seniors during sessions

3. What will seniors learn?

How to use iPads

Online safety and security tips
How to access faith-based resources online
4. What is the role of Volunteer Tech Assistants? Volunteers will provide one-on-one support to seniors, assist with technology questions, and help create a welcoming learning environment.
5. How long is the program, and when does it start? The program runs for 8 weeks with weekly 2-hour sessions starting September 6, 2025.
6. Where will sessions be held? At The Place UMC – Family Life Center.
7. Is there a cost to participate? No, the program is free for both seniors and Volunteer Tech Assistants.
