14U Rules

NFHS rules apply unless otherwise noted



**In addition to general tournament rules.*

- 1) Pool play games will last 6 innings.
- 2) 1 hr. 45 min. time limit. No new inning after the time limit. Any inning that starts within 10 minutes of the time limit will be considered the last inning of the game - at umpire's discretion. The last inning will be "open" with no cap on runs scored.
- 3) Tournament games will last 7 innings and have no time limit.
- 4) 12 run rule after 4, 10 run rule after 5 innings or any complete inning thereafter during pool play.
- 5) 10 run rule after 5 innings or any complete inning thereafter during tournament play.
- 6) 90' bases and 60' 6" pitching rubber.
- 7) Pitchers can pitch a maximum of 4 innings per game and 8 innings per day (1 pitch = 1 inning).
- 8) Extra hitter may be optionally used by either team.
- 9) Designated Hitter (DH) may be used per OHSAA rules
- 10) Maximum 9 runs scored per inning, except the last scheduled inning or last inning as declared by time limit and after. In case of an inning ending multi-run hit, only 9 runs count.

B. BAT RESTRICTIONS

- 1) USSSA 1.15 bats are permitted to be used provided that they are a maximum drop 5 (-5).
- 2) BBCOR.50 bats are permitted to be used
- 3) Wooden bats are permitted to be used provided that they are produced by a licensed manufacturer.
