### **Halloween Information**

#### **4th/5th Grade Information:**

This year, like last year, celebrations will be in the classroom with students and staff only. Each celebration will be about one hour in length. Your child's teacher will reach out if they need anything for the party. Please remember that any food items that are brought in need to be pre-packaged. Here are additional informational items:

- Celebrations will include the option of costumes and take place by grade level on Monday, October 31.
- We ask that students either wear their costume to school or wear black/orange/Halloween shirts. We do not want to have students change into costumes at school.
- No costume masks will be allowed.
- Costumes will be worn during lunch/recess.
- Costumes may not include blood, gore or weapons. While clown costumes are not specifically prohibited, we ask the scary clown costumes not be part of this event.
- Please do not send fake swords, knives, guns or any other replica of a weapon as part of a Halloween costume.

#### **6th/7th Grade Parent Update Information:**

While 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will not have a Halloween celebration, they will be allowed to participate in the special day by wearing a costume if they are willing to make a small donation. The cost to wear a costume for 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> grade students (and staff) will be \$1.00 and all proceeds will go to support the VFW of Corunna. Halloween costumes should be school appropriate and follow basic dress code expectations as well as the following criteria:

- No costume masks will be allowed.
- Costumes may not include blood, gore or weapons. While clown costumes are not specifically prohibited, we ask the scary clown costumes not be part of this event.
- Please do not send fake swords, knives, guns or any other replica of a weapon as part of a Halloween costume.
