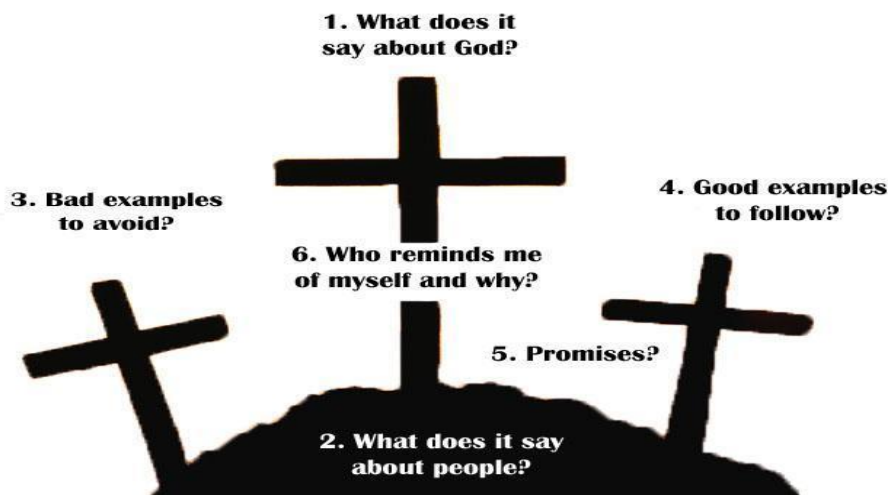


Cross Questions

A simple way to remember the Cross Questions:

1. The Cross points up, reminding me to ask, *"What does this story say about Jesus or God?"*
2. The Cross points down, reminding me to ask, *"What does this story say about people?"*
3. One thief mocked Jesus, reminding me to ask, *"Are there any bad examples to avoid?"*
4. The other thief confessed his sins, reminding me to ask, *"Are there any good examples to follow?"*
5. Jesus gave the confessing thief a promise, reminding me to ask, *"Are there any promises in this story?"*
6. Since Jesus died a death he didn't deserve, for me, I am reminded to ask, *"Who in this story reminds me of myself and why?"*
