Canterbury School Acceptable Use Policy and Agreement 5th and 6th Grades 2017-2018

Canterbury School supports a wide range of educational technologies for student, staff and faculty use. Use of these technologies is a privilege and is subject to a variety of terms and conditions. Because violations of the rules and guidelines in this policy reflect not only upon students but also upon the school, we reserve the right to address any inappropriate use of the Internet, whether on or off the Canterbury School website or campus, including harassment or the use of insulting or threatening language. Should a violation occur, consequences may include: revocation of technology access privileges, school disciplinary action, and/ or appropriate legal action.

Good citizenship includes thoughtful and careful use of technology. It is students' responsibility to be thoughtful and careful in their use of technology and to treat both the equipment and fellow users with respect.

We often share the following teaching point with the students: You may use your device in a classroom, when directed by a teacher, for a purpose the teacher directs.

- While at Canterbury School ONLY the Canterbury network will be utilized. Canterbury School
 maintains a firewall and may monitor any device on the Canterbury School network.
- Canterbury School technology and approved devices are intended for educational purposes only. Educational time includes before school, during lunch and breaks, and after school.
- iPads are not to be used as communication devices (Messaging, FaceTime, AirDrop, etc.) during academic time unless permission is given by a teacher. Bringing phones and smartwatches to school is discouraged. If brought to school, these devices must be turned off and kept in lockers.
- Students are not permitted to utilize anyone else's technological device(s) under any circumstances without this individual's express permission.
- No media (pictures, video, and audio recordings) may be recorded or used under any circumstances without the express permission of the person or people involved.
- A student may not utilize another student's login or password under any circumstances unless s/he
 has the express permission of a teacher or staff member.
- Students, staff, and faculty must abide by all licensing agreements, copyright laws, and intellectual property laws.
- All Canterbury School accounts, including Google and PowerSchool Learning accounts, are for academic purposes only.
- Canterbury School reserves the right to change such terms and conditions at any time.
