

## Greetings 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade Families,

This document explains classroom management procedures for our classes. Teachers will use Classdojo to provide parents with information on how their child is behaving in our classes every week. What you want to see and celebrate at home is your child getting positive feedback comments from their teachers, about two to three per week on Classdojo. It's a great way for you to celebrate your child's accomplishment. Here are the rules and consequences we will be following to ensure that everyone can learn in our class:

- 1. Listen and follow directions.
- 2. Keep your hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
- 3. Respect your classmates and your teachers.
- 1st consequence: warning
- 2nd consequence: time-out in the classroom
- 3rd consequence: message home

If your child breaks a class rule, we will follow the consequences listed above and teachers will also leave a comment on Classdojo. Rule breaking deducts a point on Classdojo and parents will be able to read what their child did. If your child breaks rules three times in one day, your child will get a second in-class time-out as well as a letter for you to sign. Your child must give you the letter and return it to their teacher the next day. The goal is for you to never see that letter again.:)
