

6th Grade Running Club: Meet Schedule

All races are *optional* but runners are encouraged to do at least a few during the season. You may choose which races you'd like to commit to and pay in advance; otherwise, commitment and money will be collected no later than the Thursday before the race on a weekly basis. Accepted payment: cash or check made out to "Jackson XC Parents". Or you may pay for the entire series in advance for \$52 (this only includes the 4 Sunday ATC races).

Each of the Sunday races will be 1.5 miles long. The Louisville race and the FLC meet race are each 1 mile. For Sunday races, **runners should arrive by 2:30pm to sign in and warm up.** **Races are COED and start at 3pm.** The awards are separated for girls and boys and the team with the most points wins the meet.
