

Fairview Township Supervisor Meeting Minutes

Kozak Room – Vermillion Public Library

August 14th, 2023

I. Call to order

Angela Jackson, Township Clerk, called to order the regular meeting of the Fairview Township at 7:05 pm on August 14th, 2023, for the purpose of new business and paying bills.

II. Roll call

The following persons were present: Max Andersen, Mike Seiner, Todd Mockler, Jamie Neitzke, and Angela Jackson (Clerk). Guests: Lance Hays, Charles Lovett, Connie Lovett.

III. Old Business

Approval of minutes from last meeting

Minutes from the July 10th meeting were read. Motion to approve by Max Anderson. Seconded by Todd Mockler. Minutes approved.

IV. New business

- 1) **Alley Vacate** – The third party involved in the alley vacate petition did not agree to sign the petition. Alternatively, Lance Hays would like to vacate the 132 feet of the south side of the alley with a width of 10 feet and leave the north 10 feet in place. The Lovett's would like to leave the north side in place which borders their property. The petition process will start over. Angela to check with SDATAT with the public input process since it doesn't involve other parties. Todd Mockler made the motion to move forward with the petition to vacate the south 10' of the alley contiguous to Lance Hays property. Seconded by Max Anderson. Motion passed.
- 2) **Warrant listing** – Treasurer presented bills to be paid in the amount of \$1,146.49 including payroll. No deposits. Motion made by Mike Seiner. Second by Max Anderson. Motion passed. See attached warrant listing.
- 3) **Tree removal** – extension request from Bruce Plate and Mr. Knutson to later in the year. They need more time to find help to take them down. Supervisors agreed to grant the extra time.

- 4) **Pollman gravel** – no response on gravel contract deliveries so far this year. Todd Mockler made the motion to get gravel down in critical areas asap by going with the backup contract offer for gravel with Reichnagle. Second by Max Anderson. Motion passed.
- 5) **EMC Insurance renewal** - Motion made by Max Anderson to renew insurance policy. Seconded by Todd Mockler.
- 6) **CD Renewal** - The certificate of deposit by First bank and trust No. 1270118085 has a current balance of \$17,944.49 and will autorenew on 8/17/2023 and expires on 2/17/2024. Will be discussed at next meeting.
- 7) **Propane prepay** - Southeast Farmer's Coop offered a prepaid price to the township for propane for \$1.48/gallon subject to change. Max Anderson motioned to send a check for prepaying propane. Second by Todd Mockler.

Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm. Next regular scheduled meeting is scheduled for Monday, Sept. 11, 2023, at 7 pm at the Kozak Room in the Vermillion Public Library.
