Howarth Park, Santa Rosa, CA - visit the park, hiking trails, lake, carousel and ride the train

<u>Kelly Park</u>, San Jose, CA - visit History San Jose and <u>ride historic trolley cars</u>, the Japanese friendship Garden and Happy Hollow Zoo,

Niles Canyon Railway. Niles or Sunol, CA - ride the train, visit the depot museum and see the model train layouts

<u>Pixieland.</u> Concord, CA - miniature, rideable "Pixieland Express" train rides and other attractions

Redwood Valley Railroad, Tilden Regional Park, Orinda, CA - Ride the train through the park

Napa Valley Wine Train, Napa, CA - ride the train and sample wines or take the dinner train

Nevada County Narrow Gauge Railroad Museum, Nevada City, CA - ride the railbus

Oakland Zoo Express Train, Oakland, CA - visit the zoo and ride the train

Timber Heritage Association, Samoa or Eureka, CA - ride speeder cars along the rails

Yosemite Mountain Sugar Pine Railroad, Fish Camp, CA - tide the historic logging train through the forest
