Living with a Kingdom Heart-set

Living with a Kingdom heart-set might sound like an abstract idea. But if we choose to listen to God's Word and let it sink in, we can actually make changes in our daily routines and attitudes to cultivate a Kingdom heart-set. Having eternity in mind from the time we wake up to when we lie down to sleep can really be a game changer. Since we don't know when our 'someday' is coming, we could shift to thinking it might be today. So we should strive to be prepared by living with the idea that heaven is now and heaven is here.

How do we live with a Kingdom heart-set:

Live for Today – Do you live in the moment, or do you let the moments get away from you? How would your day be different if you took time to just prepare your heart and mind to let God use you? *Matthew 25:1-13; Joshua 24:15*

Two Keys to Living for Today:

1. **Grow yourself rightly** - 2 *Peter 3:18; Ephesians 4:15; Galatians 6:8-10*
 - a. Read the Bible and be in fellowship with other believers.
 - b. What needs to grow in you? What areas of your life could benefit if you allowed God to shed His light on them?
 - c. What needs to go? What things in your daily routine hinder you from connecting more deeply with the thought of spending eternity with God?
2. **Show yourself righteously** – 2 *Corinthians 5:20-21; Matthew 6:31-33; Romans 10:11, 14-15*
 - a. Realize that you are an ambassador for God and act accordingly.
 - b. How can you share the wonderful things about God and His Kingdom with others?
 - c. What do others see in you when you are growing in Christ?

Love for Tomorrow – Do your interactions with others show them that you will love them tomorrow? What does it look like to “love someone as if their life depends on it”?
