**TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AMENDMENT**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Board of Public Safety of the City of Hornell, N.Y., and the same hereby is resolved, ordained and enacted, that §300-54 of the Traffic Ordinance of the City of Hornell is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

**That stop signs replace yield signs at the intersection of Hartshorn and Sherman streets.**

**This amendment is to take effect immediately and the same is to be published immediately.**

**Any ordinances heretofore adopted, which are inconsistent with the foregoing, are hereby rescinded.**
