

Rules on Bill Appearance Resolution

A Resolution To:

A resolution to amend the rules of the assembly to enforce a professional appearance on all legislation.

Whereas, the legislation of Dixie should be held to a professional standard, including the appearance of a bill, resolution or amendment.

Be it resolved by the Assembly of the State of Dixie.

Section 1: Resolution Name

- A. This resolution shall be referred to as “Rules on Bill Appearance Resolution.”

Section 2: Resolution Provisions

- A. Rule 5.1 of the [Rules of the Dixie Assembly](#) shall be amended as follows:
 - a. Title: Forms of Measures; Sponsorship Transactions; Formatting of Legislation:
 - i. (e) Bills submitted to the legislature must follow the proper formatting as outlined in [this document](#). All bills must have a section for the title, a section for policy, a section for an enactment clause. A bill may have a Whereas section, Definition section and a Finding section. All bills must state the author’s name and any co-sponsors at the bottom under the enactment clause.

Section 5 - Enactment

- A. This resolution shall go into effect immediately after it is passed.
- B. If any portion of this resolution is struck down, the rest of the resolution shall still be in effect.
