Halcyon Daily

News programming for Halcyon, they focus on reports from around the city and closest outlying homesteads. Catch news and weather updates at 6AM, 12PM and 6PM daily.

Wake Up! With Kishan Sibusiso

A morning radio show that focuses more on pop culture, interspersed with music picks from Kishan himself. This is your typical morning radio show.

- ***Wake Up! Weekends with Dani Bear***, same concept but exclusive to sat/sun.

The Crunch

The most listened to radio show, it's 90% music with various little fluff pieces and funny conversations between hosts DJ Prayer and Dominika Corey.

Nightowls

A late night talk radio show that reads letters sent in by Halcyon City residents. They do anything from missed connections to poems and short stories or even anonymous love letters. Are you brave enough to submit? Hosted by Ella Alden and Juma Shakti.

Into the Unknown

A nightly talk radio show about the strange and unexplainable. This is your typical paranormal podcast type deal, with stories sent in by listeners about anything from ghosts to suspected gods. Hosted by Cillian Ryan and Adam Spencer.

A weekly talk radio show about unsolved crime cases. The hosts Quintus James and Maxine Lockley get drunk on air and go over unsolved crime cases and try to solve them.

Duelling Bards

Each week unknown bards fight for their song to become Song of the Week on The Crunch. The one that wins is played regularly for the next week.

Radio Dramas

Solo Musicians

Aislinn

Think Frazey Ford or Lana Del Rey. Aislinn is a soft spoken woman with a beautiful voice that people tend to line up for. Doesn't do shows often so she sells out quickly.

Cotton

Pop punk artist in the style of Mitski or Florence + The Machine. She's small, energetic and her songs range from soft and gentle to fast and loud. Tours frequently, very much an artist of the people.
