FORMER OSHKOSH MAN REPORTED WOUNDED

Word has just been received that Pvt. First Class Louis Bauernfeind, 26, of Superior, formerly of Oshkosh, is missing in action in France since Aug. 24. Private Bauernfeind is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Adolph Bauernfeind, 604 Ninth street, and had been employed in Superior for approximately three years before entering service. Inducted in service Dec. 18, 1942, he arrived in England on June 22, 1944 and served with the infantry. He is a graduate of Oshkosh High school. At present, his wife and son are visiting his parents here.

LOUIS BAUERNFEIND REPORTED AS PRISONER SOMEWHERE IN GERMANY

Pfc. Louis Bauernfeind, son of Mr. and Mrs. Adolph Bauernfeind, 604 Ninth street, has been reported a prisoner of war in Germany.

This information was reported by his family today. The private's wife and son of Superior, Wis., are here visiting the Oshkosh youth's parents in this city.
