 - **Leadership in Curriculum, Instruction, and Supervision, September 2019-Present**
This course is designed to give the candidate a basic understanding of backward curriculum design, effective assessment practices, and supervision of personnel that supports the educational process.
 - **Leadership in Law and Personnel, September 2019-Present**
Provides the basic knowledge and processes in school law and personnel management which are needed to serve as a public-school administrator. Opportunities will be given to review and apply school law and personnel practices in specific areas using a practical approach. Implications of special education laws and regulations will be given an additional emphasis.
 - **Leadership in Organizational Management, September 2018 – Present**
This course focuses on the process of leadership, influence, power/authority and decision making

- as these relate to school administration. A biblical perspective on organizational functioning is included.
