I. Window Painting

Guidelines

IV. Powder Puff

Guidelines:

- 1. General football guidelines apply
- 2. All players must submit an <u>agreement form</u> (to Mr. Huber)
- 3. All players must wear a mouth-guard
- 4. Screen blocking, no use of hands to block or rush the QB
- 5. Five "Apple" count before rushing the QB
- 6. No tackling, flag off a runner is down; no "flag tying"
- 7. One time-out per half per team
- 8. Seven (7) player format
- 9. Sixty (60) yard field
- 10. Time
 - a. Semifinals: two 15 minutes halves with a running clock, 5 minute half-time
 - b. Finals: two 20 minute halves with a running clock; 5 minute half-time
- 11. Ties decided by three plays to score from 10 yd line
- 12. NEW: if within 10 yds from touchdown on 4th down, you have the option for a 20-yd field goal. (NOTE: the orange kicking tee will be used for this. No holder. No defense)

Each class must supply:

- 1. a squad roster
- 2. NO MORE THAN TWO student coaches
- 3. consistent uniform
- Student Council will supply refs, scorekeeper, and announcer
- No male cheerleaders

V. Floats

Guidelines:

- 1. trailer size: approx 10' in length
- 2. entire trailer must be covered
- 3. work must stop no later than 11:00 pm each night
- 4. students may be incorporated into the float (beware, too many people may detract from the aesthetics of the float (thus losing pts)

5. students may ride in the truck pulling the float

Each class must supply:

- 1. suitable working environment with constant adult supervision
- 2. suitable trailer
- 3. truck capable of pulling the float
