Fin Pin offers a orca pin (this pin comes in black or pink and 20% of the proceeds benefit The Hydrophone Project by Orca Conservancy., a sea turtle pin (and consequently 20% of the proceeds support the In Water Research Group's coastal habitat protection efforts), a sawfish pin or a hammerhead pin (you'll help fund the conservation activities of Sharktopia), and other pins on the website (Fin Pin website!), and lastly a 4ocean bracelet where you pick a cause you want to donate to and get a bracelet. They are \$20, but it's a great cause (40cean Braclet) All in all, I hope you know why
