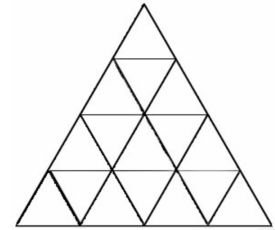
ELA

Social and Emotional

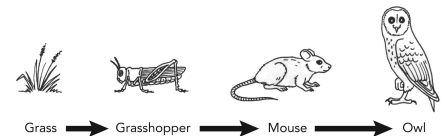
