
SPRINT 22 CHANGE MANAGEMENT - RELEASE NOTES

The following improvements and bug fixes in Sprint 22 have been made to the SCORE.org website and chapter websites on 5/30/2023. Please see the details of each change below and email campaigns@score.org if you have questions.

SR-1119 - Make All Locations and In Person restrictions more clear

Description: We've made it so that "All Locations" and "In Person" can't be selected together. However, it's not clear what's happening to the end user. Implement the following: If you select All Locations, then In Person, add a warning to the page.

Behavior Change: We added an in-line warning to Mentor Matchmaker to give end users immediate feedback when they select All Locations and In Person. This will clarify that an invalid selection has been made. The warning text is configurable by SCORE system admins - this can be edited in the Mentor Matchmaker settings.







SR-1118 - Assume all mentors speak English

Description: Assume all mentors speak English in mentor matchmaker. Currently, the mentors must match a selected language - some mentors don't add English to their profile in Engage, so we need to assume every mentor speaks English and not exclude them based on that.

Behavior Change: We now assume all mentors speak English and will not exclude mentors from the search results if they do not have English selected in their profile in Engage.

SR-1105 - Deactivate drupal location if inactive in salesforce

Description: An issue related to a zip code entered to find a mentor was reported by the field. When this zip code (Wellesley, MA 04282) is entered, it leads people to the Southern Maine chapter but the Central Maine chapter is the closest according to Google. On further investigation, the reason for this is that there are two active chapter locations with the same address. One is inactive in Salesforce. It is necessary to deactivate the location in Drupal if it is marked inactive in Salesforce.

Behavior Change: We are using the Status flag in Salesforce to determine if a branch is Published in Drupal. If a branch is marked as Inactive, we will Unpublish the branch in Drupal. If the branch is marked as Active or does not have the Status field populated we will leave the branch Published.

Important for Chapters: If you have a branch that is no longer active, select the status as inactive in Engage, in order for the branch to be unpublished on the Drupal website. This will alleviate potential problems with clients being directed to the wrong or inactive branch.
