

THIS GUIDE IS MEANT FOR COMPLETIONISTS AND AS SUCH CONTAINS UNMARKED SPOILERS!!

The aim of this guide is to provide a list of what you should do at each time period to get all real world-related **achievements** (including **Universally Loved**), and generally experience as much of it as you can since you probably skipped over 99% of it your first playthrough (I don't blame you). Remember to rotate your saves, I highly recommend you install the Improved Save & Load Menu mod for your own sanity.

Remember to name Sunny **"OMOCAT"** to get the **"So you think you're clever, huh..."** achievement. You'll get the achievement as soon as you hit OK, so when the game asks "The boy's name is OMOCAT?" you can hit NO to go back and change it (and leave it as SUNNY... as you should).

DAY 1 (THREE DAYS LEFT...)

MORNING

- Brush your teeth before opening the door for Kel by interacting with the sticky notes on the mirror in Sunny's bathroom.
- Do all three part-time jobs at Gino's, Fix-It and Othermart. [**"It's honest work"** and **"Against all odds..."**]
 - Save your game beforehand and quit the job when you start one of them for the **"That can't be good for business."** achievement. Reload your save and actually do them all.
- Pick up the tutoring posters in Othermart, follow the maps to the houses and tutor the kids [**"Math Whiz"** and **"Grammar Whiz"**]. **Doing this on subsequent days will not award additional cash or achievements, and isn't necessary for the Universally Loved flowers.**
 - The answers for the math sheet are **204**, **32**, and **-2**. The answers for the grammar sheet are **on**, **adverb**, and **"I think eggplant is the better tasting soft vegetable."**
- Pick up the trash and give it to the recycling lady for extra money.
- Donate \$30 to Guitar Guy.
- Buy 6 Fish from Othermart.
- Buy Flowers from Fix-It.
- Donate \$10 to Smelly Hobo to get the "Gold" Watch, pawn it off at Hobbeez.
- Buy the **Pet Rock** from the Shopkeep at Hobbeez. **Complete the related sidequest to earn his flowers** (you can do it all as soon as you get it, see the Pet Rocks section for details). You'll get a **CD** for beating Shopkeep.

- Give any leftover cash to Old Hobo (he'll give you double what you gave him total over Days 1 and 2 after he wins the lottery on Day 3).
- Investigate the poster in the upper-right corner of Hobbiez and win the fight (just spam Attack) to get a **CD**.
- Talk to Yellow Bun Granny at the rightmost house on the tutored kids' block and fetch her prescription for her.
- Talk to Mincy in Faraway Park (always pick the "YES" option whenever you talk with her).
- Visit Cris' house next door to Kel's. Find the remote for her dad (it's under the couch). Talk to Cris in her room to start her **seashell quest**. You only need 3 to get her **Seashell Necklace** and can only get it once, but I'll tell you where all 6 are anyway.
- Find the first **Seashell** in the gardening section at the back of Fix-It.
- Talk to Kim & Vance's Mom pacing outside her house on the tutored kids' block. Get her shears for her off to the left.
- Talk to Sean and Karen (the couple) in Fix-It and select their wallpaper for them.
- Talk to the Gruff Guy (Kim & Vance's Dad) in Fix-It then go to his house at the far-left of the same street the church is on. Watch him try (and fail) to fix his leak.
- Visit the Artist's house at the far-right of Basil's block. Give her some "advice" as she's painting (select "YES" for every option).
- Feed the cat on the monkey bars in Faraway Park.
- Lose to Kim & Vance for the "**NEEERRRDDDD!!**" achievement.

*Save your game before confronting Aubrey at the church. After you retrieve Basil's album from her trash, when you're asked if you want to high-five Kel, select "No" for the "**Too Slow!**" achievement. Then reload your save and DO high-five him for the "**Up high...**" achievement. High-five him when prompted on all subsequent days for the "**Down low...**" achievement.

EVENING

- Visit Mari's grave with Kel behind the Church.
- Talk to Mincy in the produce section of Othermart.
- Talk to the man standing in front of the counter of Hobbiez. Pick the M-rated game to give to his son as a gift. He will give you a **Seashell**.
- Visit the house left of Aubrey's and save the man's wedding ring from the sink.
- Feed the cat on top of Basil's house.

DAY 2 (TWO DAYS LEFT...)

MORNING

- Brush your teeth before opening the door.
- Feed the cat on top of Sunny's house.
- Pick up trash and turn it in to the recycling lady.
- Do all the part-time jobs again to get more money, and give it all to Old Hobo.
- Talk to Mincy in the Candy Store.
- Talk to Kim & Vance's Dad in Fix-It and go to his house again to see him try (and fail) to fix the leak. Make sure to grab the [Seashell](#) in the hole he leaves behind.
- Give the [Seashells](#) to Cris and receive her [Seashell Necklace](#). You'll want to put this on Sunny, since it's one of two Charms in the real world that actually raise stats and he needs the extra Heart and Juice the most.
- Go to the Artist's house again and return Lucas to her. He's in front of Kel's house (looks like he wanted to play with Hector...). Make sure to report back to her after you send him on his way. (You can also pet Lucas for the "[Good Dog](#)" achievement if you don't already have it.)
- Take the \$20 from Kel's wardrobe. [["I'll just take that..."](#)]
- Take the Pepper Spray from Kel's Mom's purse in the dining room.

EVENING

- After Polly asks you to look for Basil, before going to the hideout check the wasp's nest near the tetherball pole to fight the wasps. [["Bees?"](#)]
- Use the Pepper Spray to beat the Hooligans. [["The Art of Self-defense"](#)]
- Feed the cat in the tree in front of Othermart, you'll get an [Arcade Piece](#).
- Give the [Arcade Piece](#) to the guy in front of the arcade machine at Gino's and you'll get a [CD](#). If you can beat his high score of 500 points he'll give you another [Seashell](#).
- Talk to Mincy in the garden section at the back of Fix-It.
- Talk to the Fashionable Mom standing outside the second house from the right on Basil's block; then go talk to her son in Fix-It near the lamps. Buy the lamp with the cash he gives you and return to his mom. [You must complete this sidequest for Recycultists' HQ to appear on Day 3.](#)
- Find the remote for Cris' dad again (it's in the bathroom).
- Go to Wrinkly Forehead's house next-door to Basil's and go to Jesse's room. Keep knocking on the door until he lets you in.
- Go to Gino's, talk to the woman standing in front of the counter, and answer Yes to her. Then go to the candy store, talk to Clumsy Guy, and select Caramel Apples. Finally, visit their house to the left of Aubrey's.
- Go into Mikhael's house and play hide-and-seek with the twins (they're under the bed in Mikhael's room).
- Get the [Seashell](#) in the hideout behind the lake.

DAY 3 (ONE DAY LEFT...)

MORNING

- Brush your teeth one last time. ["Minty Fresh"]
- Collect the return on your investment from Old Hobo.
- You can do all the part-time jobs again if you want the extra money, but you probably won't need to.
- Collect trash and turn it in to the recycling lady, she should give you a CD.
- Buy all 5 CDs from Hobbeez.
- Complete Guitar Guy's quest for another CD. Talk to his dad (in the gray house on the tutored kids' block), deliver the Lunch Box to Guitar Guy, then deliver Guitar Guy's letter back to his dad.
- Talk to Mincy in the church.
- Leave flowers at Mari's grave and have a picnic. ["When she was here..."]
- Feed the cat in the hideout spot, you'll get the last Seashell.
- Visit Sean and Karen's house to help them cook.
- Find the remote for Cris' dad one last time (it's in the pie in the kitchen).
- Visit Kim & Vance's Dad at Fix-It, then visit his house to have Aubrey finally fix the leak. You'll get a CD.
- Talk to the Artist then go fetch Angel for her (he's at Hobbeez). Make sure to report back to her after you send him on his way.
- Interact with the swings at Faraway Park for a cute cutscene with Aubrey.
- Stock up on Bandages and First-Aid Kits at the pharmacy (10 or so of each should be more than enough) and complete the Recycultist HQ dungeon located at the hideout spot (see section for more details).

EVENING

- Visit the hideout spot again and have a picnic at the blue basket for some short optional cutscenes.
- Feed the cat by Mari's grave, you should get the last CD and the "Tummy Full of Fish" achievement.
- Put all the CDs into the jukebox at Gino's for the achievement. ["Music Connoisseur of Sorts"]
- Talk to Mincy on the bench at the park.
- Attend Sean and Karen's housewarming party. ["Good Company"]

It should go without saying but save before the Omori fight. To get the "Close your eyes..." achievement, just attack normally until you die and select "No" on the Game Over screen to get the bad ending (😞). Reload your save and do the fight again and make it to the final phase, this time selecting "Yes" when asked to continue. When Sunny wakes up in the hospital you'll receive "Universally Loved" (fingers crossed you didn't miss anyone, you can interact with the flowers to read everyone's well-wishes), and when you finish the credits you'll get "One more day..." Congrats! You did it! 🎉

RECYCULTIST'S HQ

Compared to the dungeons in Headspace, the Recycultists' HQ is pretty straightforward. It's the only spot in the real world where you can actually TAG your other party members, and it should be obvious who you need to tag where.

In the battles with the individual Recycultists you'll want to Encourage Sunny with Kel and just Attack with all three party members. Sunny will do most of the damage since he has a knife and Encourage boosts his Attack all the way up. If you're lucky you'll take them out without taking damage yourself since they'll sometimes waste a turn gathering trash. Don't be shy about using those Bandages you bought to heal between battles when you need to.

You'll reach a point where there's a large group of Recycultists who stop you from going further. Tag Hero and backtrack so you can charm over the ones you've beaten (and the ones that are just sitting around) to your side until you can't hold anymore. Then go back to the large group and they'll declare it a stalemate and all leave.

Once you reach the end you'll face the Recyclepath himself. It's mostly the same strategy, just have Kel Encourage Sunny at the start and focus all your attacks on the Recyclepath. You can take out the adds, but they'll get replaced after a few turns anyway so just keep up with healing by using Bandages and First Aid Kits with Kel since he's the fastest and there's no way to revive a party member after they've been KO'd in the real world. Use Hero's First Aid skill as needed too. Aubrey's Homerun skill says it has a chance of instantly defeating an enemy, so feel free to try it on the Recyclepath and see if you get lucky (it didn't when I played it, so I actually don't know if he's immune). Keep plucking away and eventually you'll beat him and earn yourself the "Reduce, reuse, and recycle!" achievement.

PET ROCKS

You can complete this entire sidequest on Day 1 as soon as you buy the **Pet Rock** from Shopkeep at Hobbeez. It's mostly self-explanatory, you just play Rock-Paper-Scissors against other characters' Tamagochi things. The "Combo" counter indicates how many hearts of damage you'll deal to your opponent if you win the throw (your opponent can also combo you). You'll have to equip the **Pet Rock** Charm to Sunny, then you'll see an icon above characters you can battle against.

Here's a quick walkthrough of the quest:

- Beat any 4 opponents around town.
- Talk to Shopkeep who will tell you about the four Pet Rock veterans.
- Beat Glasses Guy at Gino's, Cute Girl at the candy store and Fix-It Guy.
- Go back to Shopkeep and beat him.

- Then go and beat the champion (Othermart Lady at the fish shop), and earn “The Very Best” achievement.

And here’s the strategy for every single opponent, first the people around town:

- Kel with Pluto will battle you as soon as you get your Pet Rock (he doesn’t count towards the 4 you need to beat to unlock the fights with the veterans). He’ll only ever throw Rock so just hit him with Paper to easily beat him (not that it matters).
- Colorful Girl (Katie) in Hobbeez with Tomatogirl will only ever throw Rock and Paper, so throw Paper every time to win.
- Rai in Gino’s with Bunny has a 50% chance to throw Paper, so spam Scissors to be more likely to win.
- Pretty Boy in the Park with Rose Lad only ever throws Paper and Scissors, so throw Scissors to beat him.
- Creepy Guy at Charlene’s House with Muncher King only throws Rock and Scissors, so spam Rock to win (you’ll also get a Fedora for beating him).
- Angel in his room on the Evening of Day 2 in the Artist’s house with Saucy-K only throws Scissors, so hit him with Rock to win.
- Daphne at Mikhael’s House after you win the twins’ hide-and-seek game with Papa Chip has a 50% chance to throw Rock, so spam Paper to be more likely to win.

And now for the four veterans:

- Glasses Man (Gino) at Gino’s Pizza with Lil’ G has an equal chance to throw either Rock, Paper, or Scissors. It’s all luck, so just spam one until you can brute-force a win.
- Cute Girl (Curtsey) at the Candy Store with Ocotaco has a 50% chance to throw Rock, so spam Paper to be more likely to win.
- Fix-It Guy with Ptery has a 50% chance to throw Scissors, so throw Rock to be more likely to win.
- After beating the three previous veterans, Shopkeep at Hobbeez with Cool Snake has a 50% chance of throwing Paper, so throw Scissors to win. You’ll also get a CD for beating him.

And then the Pet Rocks Champion,

- The Othermart Lady at the fish store with One Wing Jash (sometimes referred to by fans as “Sephirock”) has an equal chance to throw either Rock, Paper, or Scissors. It’s all luck, so just turn Text Skip on, hold Z and let it ride until you can brute-force out your win. Once you finally beat her you’ll earn “The Very Best” achievement as well as the “You Rock” Cap.

MISCELLANEOUS STUFF TO DO

I've covered most everything in this guide, but there's still some small things left. You'll probably notice a **Coin** or two on the ground as you're running around town. There's one **Coin** every **Morning** and **Evening**, and for every 3 you toss into the fountain at Faraway Plaza, a dollar will appear on the ground for you to find somewhere in town. I have no clue where all the **Coins** and dollars are, and it's not really worth going out of your way to do, so only go hunting around if you really feel like it.

There are also sparkling spots you can interact with around town for cute little cutscenes with Sunny and his friends. I covered the ones I think are most important in my guide but interact with them whenever you spot them. You can play fetch with Hector, play video games in Kel's Room and read comics at Hobbeez after you've got the full party, etc.

You'll probably have tons of money left over if you've been donating to Old Hobo as instructed, even after you buy all the **CDs** and healing items for Recycultist HQ. One of the other things you also probably missed was the gachapon machine in Hobbeez on the counter. Unlike real gacha games, you'll never get a duplicate. You'll need \$39 total to get them all, among them is the **Chimera Keychain**, the only real-world Charm besides the **Seashell Necklace** that actually raises stats (+5 Luck). You're free to try and get it before you do Recycultist HQ (maybe it makes Aubrey's Homerun more likely to proc), but I wouldn't worry too much about it.

Another thing you can do with your money is buy food. Normally the Snacks in the real-world are just a quick joke to subvert your expectation of food being just as effective at healing as they are in Headspace, but since you have the money and not much to do with it you can buy food at Gino's, the Bakery, and the Candy Store for a quick text box describing the taste of the food from Sunny's point of view (regardless of who you actually feed it to).

And that's all folks!
