Punny Name - Some prominent critics are known by a variety of nicknames instead of their actual names; as an example, <u>Stephanie Zvan</u> is frequently called "Stefunny" or one of <u>many</u> others.

Insider Slang - Terms like "<u>Baboons</u>" and "<u>Brave Heros</u>" are thrown around, without explanation. These can pop up and fade quickly; fortunately, <u>glossaries</u> are around to help you keep up.

Comment Editing - <u>Justicar</u>: "One of the points of pride at Abbie [Smith]'s place was that once it's said, it's said. And in order to 'unsay' it, one has to later on formally retract the claim, not to think better of it in a few minutes and go back in to edit shit." This attitude carries over to all over blogs; if they allow editing, even only by the administrator, then they must be censoring free expression. Ironically, <u>Lsuoma</u>'s iteration of the Slyme Pit <u>does permit editing</u>, which turned out to be a <u>wise move</u>.

Brave Hero - A term <u>coined by "ElevatorGATE"</u> to mock <u>Rhys Morgan</u>, a frequent target of EG's ire, who <u>may have considered revealing</u> the anonymous blogger's real name. More recently, it's been <u>championed by Justin Vacula</u> and has become a popular catchphrase.

Anonymous Comment - Some of the people who frequent the Slyme Pit post under their real names. Most, however, are anonymous. This allows them the freedom to say what they want, without facing any consequences outside the internet. Most of their ire, in contrast, is aimed at people who post under their real names, who could face consequences on the outside.
