DRESS CODE - What to keep in mind

- Appropriate fitting shorts and skirts can be worn, providing that they are no shorter than mid thigh when standing.
- Tights, yoga pants, biker shorts, etc can be worn with a shirt that extends to mid thigh.
- Clothing with rips, tears, and holes that are distracting/inappropriate/above the knee are not allowed
- Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.
- Hair will be a natural color. No extreme dyed hair
- Boys will have no facial hair.
- Gentlemen's hair will not extend past the shirt collar, cannot cover the ears and must be worn in a way that is not disruptive or covers the face.



ELECTRONIC DEVICES - What to keep in mind

Personal electronic devices, such as cell phones, <u>are required to be **turned off** and kept in the student's backpack at all times between 7:45 and 4:00.</u>

Any personal electronic device <u>seen</u> or used during the school day will be confiscated and turned into the principal's office. Parents may be required to pick up the device. Repeat offenders may have their device confiscated for multiple days and be required to pay a \$15.00 fine.

If the phone is confiscated for 24 hours:

- No charge for the first time
- 2nd time-\$15.00
- 3rd time-\$30.00 and so on...
