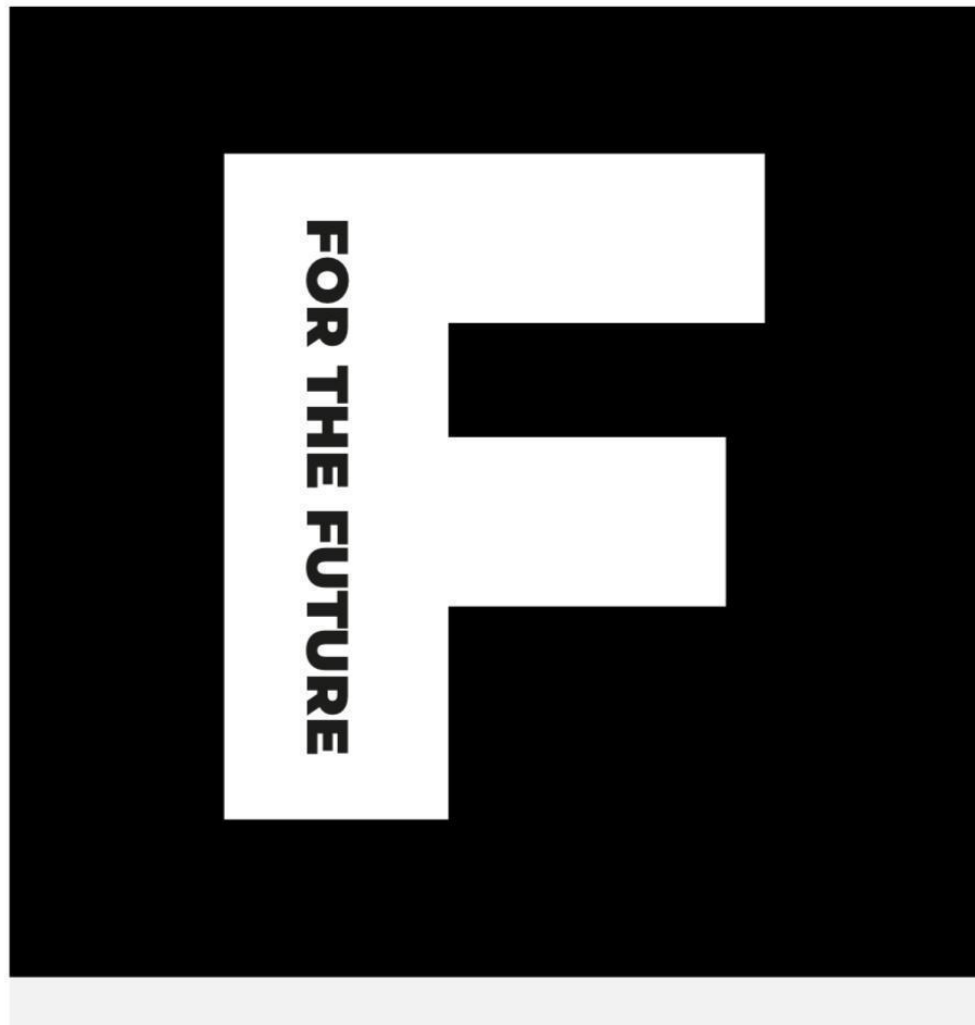

Club Car Park

The club car park is free to all members of Alsager Lawn Tennis Club. The club has experienced increased levels of unauthorised parking by non members so the club has introduced a **free annual parking permit sticker** which members are reminded to display in the rear window of their car as proof of membership.

GATE/CLUBHOUSE ACCESS

No keys are required to access the venue as the main gate access is key code entry only. **To gain access to the venue, please use the pin code detailed on your court booking email confirmation.** If you have booked a court and you are playing with other members, please share your court booking code with them.

1. Your court booking code is only valid for the time and date of your booking and is not valid at any other time.
2. Please note that your PIN for entry is valid 30 minutes before the booking time.
3. **Please note that there is no longer a Universal Gate Access code as this was causing failures in the key code entry system.**
4. Gate Access code failures, please contact Mark Bundy on 07999 442965 or report via email at Alsagerltcgateaccess@gmail.com

5. **Emergency Keysafe key is only to be used when the gate access fails to operate. Please contact Mark for the PIN code to access the keysafe.**

Access to the clubhouse is via a key safe located to the left of the main door. Please use our Clubhouse access Code to open the key safe. **This pin code will be given to you on your Welcome Email when you join the club by purchasing a membership package.**

BOOKING A COURT

ALTC operates an online court booking system via Clubspark, courts can be booked in 60 minute slots, and cannot be booked for more than two hours consecutively. **You will receive an email confirmation when you have booked a court, this will detail your unique 4 digit PIN to use when entering the main gate.**

You can share your court booking code with other players that you will be playing with to allow them access to the club.

Some courts are allocated for coaching on a Tuesday, Thursday and Friday between 4pm – 6pm and on a Saturday morning from 9am – Noon. For further information on booking a court visit our website or [click here](#).

Lighting of courts: Courts 1 , 2 , 3 and 4 all have brand new full LED lighting, FREE to all club members. The court lights switches are located in the clubhouse on the left of the main doors.

Guest fees: Members are allowed to bring guests to play up to a maximum of three times a year, the first visit is free. The visiting guest fee is £5. The fee must be paid to a committee member or coach if they are available. **A guest can play a maximum of three times at weekends, evenings or bank holidays without becoming a member.**

All visiting guests MUST sign in on the Visitors book located in the clubhouse.

Tennis Balls: Members may use balls supplied by the club, balls can also be purchased from Clive Young , our Club Committee member by calling mobile number 07785 110228.

We do operate within a tennis ball recycling scheme so please put your used balls in the clubhouse.

PLAYING RULES

Social club play: Monday evening, Saturday afternoons – tennis balls supplied.

All club members are welcome to participate in social club play held on Monday evening from 6pm and from 2pm on Saturday.

Doubles play has priority over singles play on club days/nights. Singles shall not be played when all courts are in use and other members are waiting.

- All members agree to adhere to the [Code of Conduct](#).
- Appropriate sporting attire must be worn at all times - no vests or bare chests please. To protect the court surface, tennis specific shoes must always be worn on court.
- Tennis balls are available for members to use and can be collected from inside the clubhouse.
- When you arrive, the next person available will play.
- If only two people are playing on a court, feel free to join them to make up a four.
- On completion of a set, players should vacate the court and await their turn for the next free court.
- If your set reaches 6-6 and other members are waiting to play, then you should not play a tiebreaker. If no one is waiting, playing a tie breaker is fine.
- When a member arrives to play, they have a priority to go on to the next available court ahead of those who have already played a set.
- After a set has been completed, players must leave the court and wait their turn for the next available court.
- It is also advisable to sweep the courts before playing to reduce the risk of injury.
