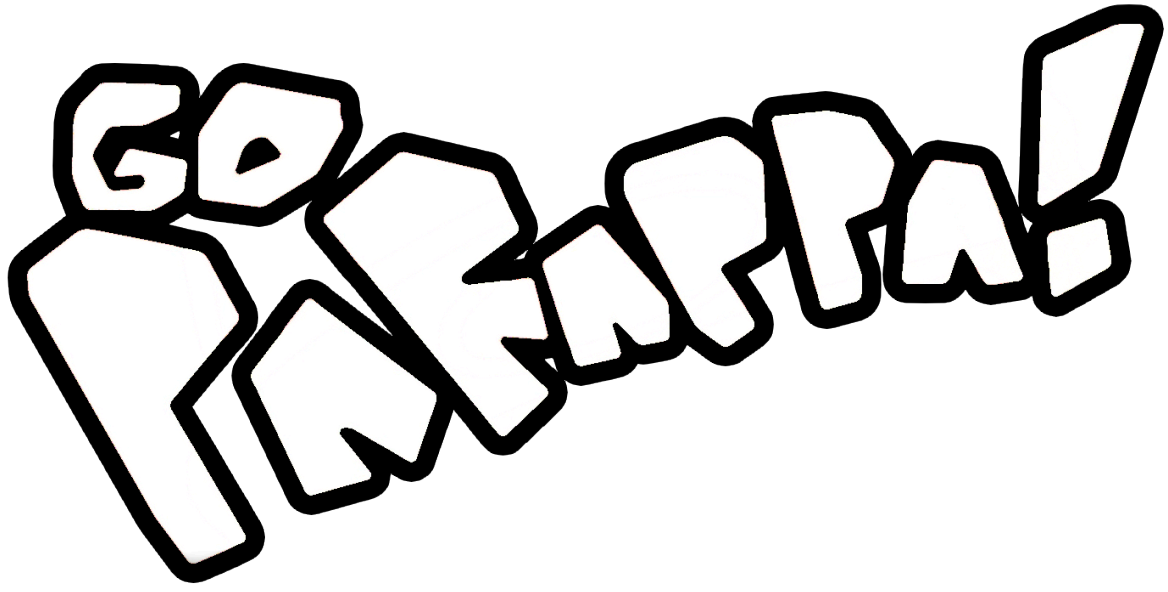

What's a fanzine?

Fanzines, short for "fan magazines" emerged in the early 20th century, with roots in science fiction fandom. They became a popular medium for fans to express their creativity and share their enthusiasm for various topics, from literature and film to music and niche hobbies.

This fanzine will be focusing on video game franchise Parappa the rapper

This project is perfect for new aspiring artists to showcase their talent, and for established artists to express themselves through an already existing property. We would love to see what you have to offer for the fanzine.

Is the zine safe for work?

Yes, all artwork in the zine will be PG-13.

How do I apply?

To apply there are some requirements you must meet before you apply.

Here are some of those requirements:

Have experience with art. we would prefer if you have some pieces to show versus you having nothing to show us.

You must be 16 or older.

Have access to any art tools or programs.

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After you meet the requirements, then:

Open up your preferred browser and sign up for this form.

This fanzine is first-come, Maximum of 1 artwork per person for now.

There is a section in the application where you have to share your art works with sending links to the platform where you share them. Examples could be traditional (pen and paper), 2D, 3D, whatever! (Except AI. AI is Prohibited). If your examples of animations have watermarks, that's fine. However, if you are accepted, your final piece cannot have a watermark (either from the program you are using or your watermark). **You will still be credited at the end of the fanzine and credits.**

If you have questions about submitting examples to us. Ask your questions via email stated above.

When accepted, please give us an update frequently. We will be requesting status updates either by social media or email frequently. If you need more time, it will only be given if your piece is nearing completion and you have given us updates on your piece.

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What should my piece look like?

After being accepted, we will send you the Discord link so that you can prepare your piece for the fanzine, and the pixel size will depend on the format and layout of the publication. Here are some general guidelines:

1. **Single page:** If you want a full-page image in a standard letter-sized fanzine (8.5 x 11 inches/2550 x 1650 pixels) and a resolution of 300 DPI
2. **Spread Page:** For images that occupy 2 pages (93.5 inches/8,976 pixels) and a resolution of 300 DPI

Don't feel chained by the original style of PTR/UJL. Get creative and show us what you've got!

You cannot include NSFW, Semi-NSFW, Gore, Racism, Homophobia, Excessively Dark Humor, Extreme drugs, Etc

Keep it friendly, please!

Maintain the essence of the original Parappa the Rapper / Um Jammer Lammy / Parappa the Rapper 2 series in your piece. Avoid content that goes against the spirit of the source material.

Communication is Key:

Use the **server** for discussions related to the fanzine project. Clear communication helps in coordinating efforts and addressing any issues promptly.

Timely Submissions:

Adhere to project deadlines. Timely submissions are crucial for the smooth progression of the fanzine project. If you encounter challenges, communicate with the organizers.

Feedback and Revision:

Be open to feedback from fellow collaborators and project organizers. If revisions are requested, make necessary adjustments promptly.

Respect Organizers' Decisions:

Respect the decisions made by the project organizers. They are working to ensure the success of the zine.

Proper Crediting:

Provide proper credits for your work. Include your username or artist name in the submitted files, and ensure that everyone involved in the project is credited appropriately.
