New Summer Coding Class at Cornerstone

In collaboration with HAK, Cornerstone is pleased to offer our families the opportunity to enroll in summer coding classes during June 16-20 and June 23-27 at our Manuela Campus, located at 4243 Manuela Ave, Palo Alto, CA 94306. Students who have not signed up for the Cornerstone Chinese Summer Camp can also sign up for this Coding Class. The Coding Class is conducted in English.

Creative Coding for Incoming K-6th Gr. Students

In this course, students will become familiar with block coding using iPads and Octostudio. This will be a similar structure to the Coding Club that was offered during the school year. This course is suitable for all incoming Kindergarteners to incoming sixth graders. Each class will be 40 minutes long from 3:10 PM to 3:50 PM.

Circuits and Coding for Incoming 2nd-6th Gr. Students

This class will be the first step to help students understand how computers work. Students will be using Chromebooks to learn how to use Scratch and Makey Makey. Makey Makey helps students interact with outside sensors and code. In this course, students will build homemade electronic musical instruments and game controllers using materials like cardboard, conductive tape, Play Doh, and more! This course is suitable for all incoming second graders to incoming sixth graders. Each class will be 60 minutes long from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

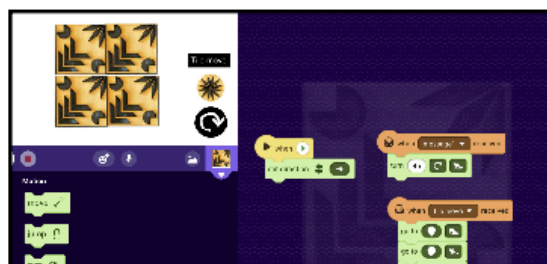
Week 1 (Jun 16 - 20): All levels guided coding

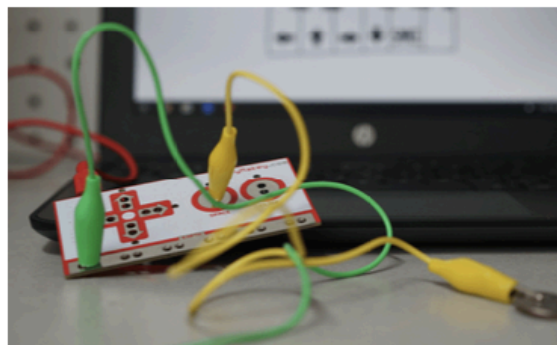
Week 1 (Jun 16 - 20): Music & Art w/ Coding
