# Privacy Policy for Better Blackboard Extension

## Introduction

This Privacy Policy describes how the Better Blackboard Extension ("we", "our", or "the extension") collects, uses, and protects your information when you use our Chrome extension.

## Information We Collect

The Better Blackboard Extension collects and processes the following types of information:

- 1. \*\*Website Content\*\*: We access and parse content from the Blackboard website (https://blackboard.cune.edu) to extract assignment and course information. This data is used solely for displaying information within the extension.
- 2. \*\*Web History\*\*: The extension accesses the Blackboard activity feed to retrieve assignment information. This is limited to the Blackboard website and is used solely for displaying assignments within the extension.
- 3. \*\*User Activity\*\*: We track user interactions within the extension itself, such as refreshing data or adding course materials. This information is used to improve the user experience.
- 4. \*\*User Preferences\*\*: We store user preferences, such as theme choice (light or dark mode), to personalize the extension experience.

## How We Use Your Information

The information we collect is used for the following purposes:

- 1. To display your assignments and course materials within the extension
- 2. To provide a personalized user experience
- 3. To improve the functionality and performance of the extension

## Data Storage and Security

All data collected by the extension is stored locally on your device using Chrome's storage API. We do not transmit or store your data on external servers.

## Third-Party Services

The extension uses CDN-hosted libraries (Bulma CSS and Font Awesome) to improve the user interface. These libraries are loaded from trusted sources and do not access or collect your personal data.

## ## Your Rights

You have the right to:

- 1. Access the data stored by the extension on your device
- 2. Request deletion of your data (which can be achieved by uninstalling the extension)
- 3. Object to the processing of your data
