## Drop-Off, Pick-Up, Traffic

For 2020-21 we have some updates to help maintain a healthy school campus. Please be sure to study the traffic patterns carefully.

Important changes include 1) students may not exit vehicles until AFTER completing the daily screening with a P.K. Yonge staff member 3) vehicles may not park, and 4) only P.K. Yonge students may exit vehicles on campus.

### **North Campus | Front Circle | Morning Drop-Off**

In the morning on the North End of campus, the Front Gate Opens at 7:00am for P.K. Yonge staff and faculty. Students MAY NOT BE DROPPED OFF until 7:30am and MAY NOT EXIT VEHICLES until they have completed the daily screening. Vehicles dropping off elementary students and families with both elementary and secondary students may enter the front circle for morning drop-off. Student drivers with elementary siblings must enter campus through the 16th Avenue gate. Only P.K. Yonge students may exit vehicles on campus and only after completing the daily screening and when directed by a P.K. Yonge staff member.

#### **Enter the Front Gate After 7:30am**

Cars proceed into the Front Circle in **one** lane.

Families and students remain in their cars.

Vehicles pull forward to the top of the circle.

Students wait to be met at the vehicle by a P.K. staff member.

Students put on their masks.

Students roll down the window and complete the screening process as necessary.

When prompted, students exit the vehicle on the right hand side (curb side).

Students proceed to the designated morning meeting location for their cohort.

Vehicles may not park.

Drivers/family members may not exit vehicles on campus and walk students in to school

Vehicles exit campus at the top of the front circle.

## Drop-Off, Pick-Up, Traffic

### North Campus | Front Circle | Afternoon Pick-Up

In the afternoon, the Front Gate opens at **2:00pm (M,T, Th, F) /12:15pm (W)** for families. Vehicles picking up elementary students, and families with both elementary and secondary students may pick students up in the Front Circle. Family members may NOT exit vehicles while waiting to pick up students.

Cars drive up to the Front Gate.

Drivers tell the gate guard the name/s and grades of the children they are picking up.

Cars then proceed into the Front Circle in one lane.

Drivers and passengers remain in cars to wait for school dismissal.

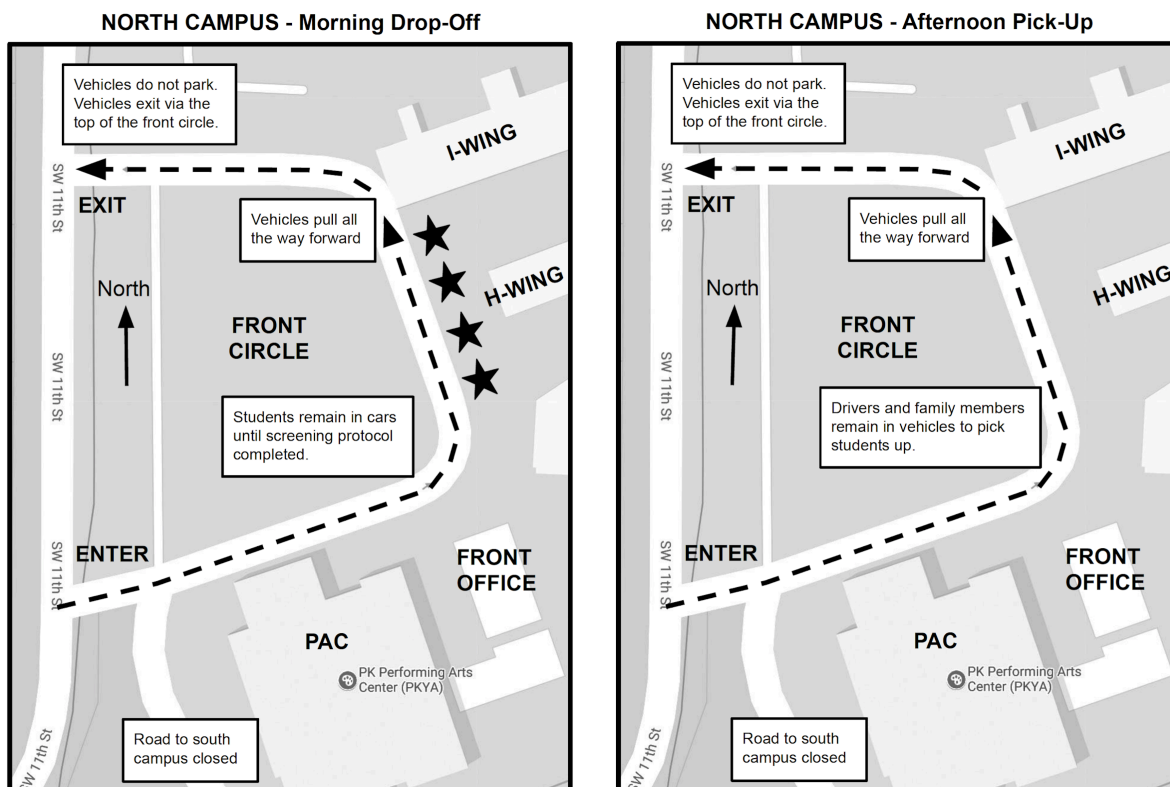
Student gets into the car.

Vehicles proceed through the Front Circle.

Vehicles may not park.

Drivers, family members may not exit their vehicles on campus.

Vehicles exit campus at the top of the front circle.

## Drop-Off, Pick-Up, Traffic

### **South Campus | 16th Avenue | Morning Drop-Off**

In the morning on the South End of campus, the gate opens at **7:20am**

Vehicles dropping off secondary students and student drivers may enter the south end of campus for morning drop off. Student drivers with elementary siblings must enter campus through the south gate, accessed by turning from SW 16th Avenue gate onto SW 10th Terrace. Only P.K. Yonge students may exit vehicles on campus and only after completing the daily screening and when directed by a P.K. Yonge staff member.

#### **For Families Dropping Off Students**

Family vehicles dropping off students proceed through the gate and remain in the RIGHT hand lane.

Families and students remain in their cars.

Vehicles move forward in the right hand lane as other vehicles move up

Students wait to be met at the vehicle by a P.K. staff member.

Students put on their masks.

Students roll down the window and complete the screening process as necessary.

When prompted by a P.K. staff member, students exit the vehicle.

Students proceed to the designated morning meeting location for their cohort.

Vehicles may not park.

Drivers, family members may not exit their vehicles on campus.

Vehicles exit campus through the 16th Street gate.

#### **For Student Drivers**

Student-driven vehicles proceed through the gate and remain in the LEFT hand lane.

Student drivers remain in their cars.

Vehicles move forward in the left hand lane as other vehicles move up.

Students wait to be met at the vehicle by a P.K. staff member.

Students put on their masks.

Students roll down the window and complete the screening process as necessary.

When directed by a P.K. staff member, students park their vehicles.

After parking, students must exit vehicles immediately.

Students may not invite other students into their vehicles.

Students proceed to the designated morning meeting location for their cohort.

## Drop-Off, Pick-Up, Traffic

### **South Campus | 16th Avenue | Afternoon Pick-Up**

At the sound end of campus the south gate (accessed from SW 16th Avenue by turning on to SW 10th Terrace) opens at 1:50pm (M,T,Th, F) /12:45pm (W) for families.

#### **For Families Picking Up Students**

Family vehicles proceed through the gate and form ONE lane.

Drivers and passengers remain in cars to wait for school dismissal.

Student gets into the car.

Vehicles proceed through the loop.

Vehicles may not park.

Drivers, family members may not exit their vehicles on campus.

Vehicles exit campus through the 16th Street Gate.

#### **For Student Drivers**

Students proceed to their cars immediately after the school day ends.

Student gets into the car.

Students turn left into the traffic lane furthest from the gym.

Student driver passes by the gym on the outside lane.
