For Windows

Installation

1. For Mumble Installation need access to the link: <https://www.mumble.com/mumble-download.php> and download mumble for windows client (right side of the main screen).
2. Execute the installation package

Configuration

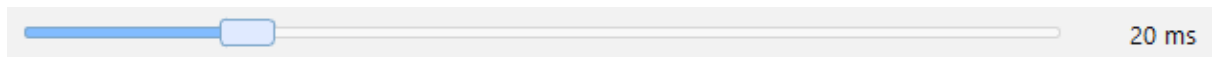
For the first time using Mumble, you need to personalize your Mumble configuration following the audio and sound steps. You would be able to change this configuration at any time you want, but we recommend you to follow the next recommendations.

1. On the Device Selection window, mark the boxes

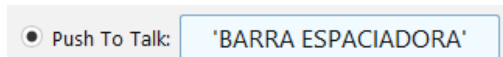
Use echo cancellation and Attenuate applications while other users talk

On this screen you can check your microphone operation, it's already turned on and you can check your voice replayed by the audio system. You can also check which microphone will be used, the pre-selected option generally is the right-one option.

2. On the next screen, you should reduce the following bar the less possible, checking don't have audio distortions or interruptions.



3. On the Volume Tuning screen, you will choose the microphone sensibility and audio levels. Your voice needs to be over the green bar; don't move too much the blue bar. We allow you to use headphones in Mumble. If there is excessive sound (the red bar), turn down the volume of your audio.
4. On the Voice Activity Detection screen, we strongly recommend using the **Push to talk** option and choose a specific button from your keyboard to turn on your microphone in your participation, this option reduces the echo in the conversation. For this, choose the option Push to talk, and in the next section use the shortcut for selecting a button.



Only choose one button.

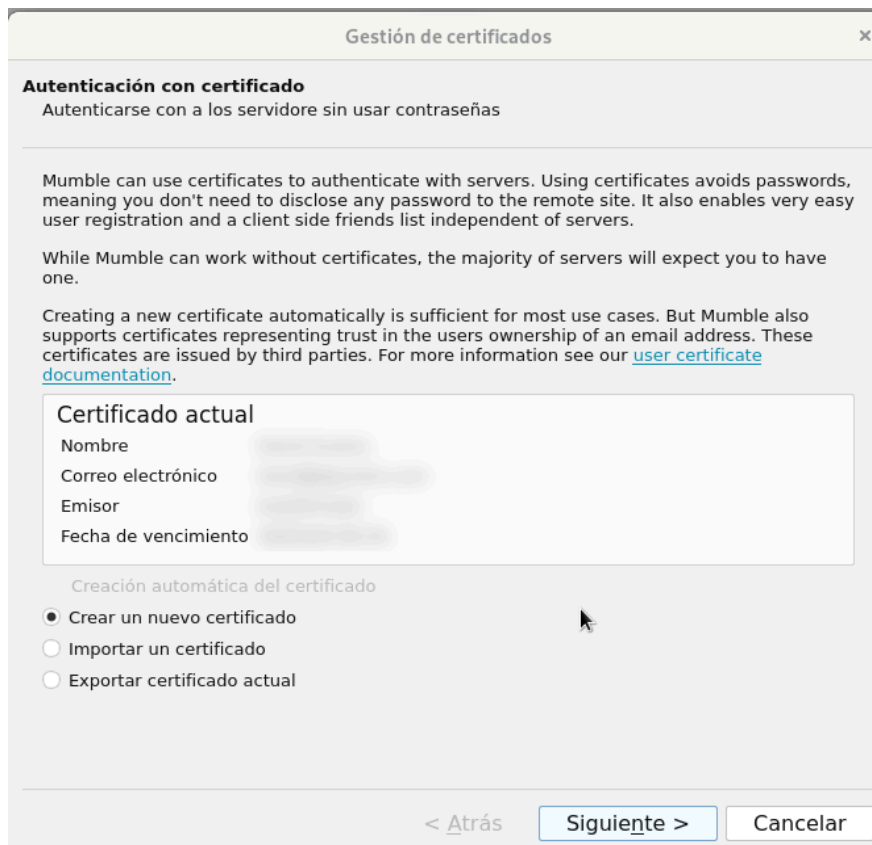
5. On the next screen isn't necessary to modify the options- You can come back to modify the configuration on the main screen in Configuration and choose the Audio Wizard option or Audio assistance.

Choose a Server

1. Click on
2. Copy and paste the next link: **mumble.apuntia.com**
3. Write your Username for other participants.
4. Finally, you can enter the server and start chatting with other people.

Configure your online identity

If you didn't do this before, now is the time to configure your Mumble certificate. In order to do this, go to the Settings menu and choose the "Certificate Wizard" option. A dialog will open:



5. If the information shown is correct, particularly your name and your email address, there is nothing else to do; you can just enjoy the event. Otherwise, please choose the "Create a new certificate" option to replace the existing one. Click "Next", introduce your name and email address, and confirm that you want to replace the current certificate with the new one. Don't hesitate and click "Next", so Mumble will have the right information and we will be able to identify you and give you access to the conference.
6. Finally, if you are a speaker or are going to comment on a session, we ask you to please send us an email telling us which your username is or you can double click at the Help_Desk channel on Mumble once you are connected. There we will bring you help.

For Android System

1. Download the "Mumla" application from PlayStore.

2. On your screen is going to appear a white screen, you can add your server with the “+” button on the superior right screen.
3. On the next screen you need to upload the Host Direction: **mumble.apuntia.com**
4. Add the server and you will be able to connect to the server and start to talk.
