

## **Home School Academy Purchasing Matrix**

This document is intended as a reference guide and is **NOT** inclusive of all items that can or cannot be ordered.

All orders will be reviewed for reasonableness. Items ordered are for student and parent educator use only. Visions In Education (VIE) makes every effort to ensure that funds from the State of California are utilized in the most efficient manner to support the school and the students. Student funding cannot be spent on an item that could be construed as a "gift of public funds."

When placing orders for curriculum, review all items carefully. The only items that may be **returned for credit** are items purchased through MBS (excluding Marketplace items) and TextbookX (supported curriculum only, excludes warehouse and marketplace items). These items must be returned to the Carmichael Resource Center no later than **September 20**, **2019** (for Fall semester orders through **September 20**) and by **February 21**, **2020** (for Spring semester orders from **December 1** - **February 21**).

All items ordered are the property of VIE and are returnable at the end of the student's enrollment (withdrawal or graduation). For continuing students, items not returned at the end of the school year will be automatically retained in Launchpad at no charge and will maintain their original purchase value on the Returnables screen. This does not apply to consumable items (workbooks, puzzles, manipulatives, etc.).

**Use the Note Box** for any exceptional or "out of the ordinary" orders that need to be explained, including the name of a project and any items associated with the specific project. For Partner orders, provide this information via the Help Form.

## **Important Ordering Questions:**

- Is the item educational?
- Is the quantity of the item reasonable for one student?
- Is the item a wise use of public funds?
- Is the item age/developmentally appropriate?
- Will the item be used up by the end of the school year?
- Is the item aligned with a specific course listed on the Master Agreement (Grades 9-12)?
