

Information-Seeking Personality Profile: Part 3

Lesson Plan

Learning objectives:

- Students will be able to reflect on how open they are to considering new ideas or perspectives (just considering them—not necessarily agreeing with them) by taking a semi-serious BuzzFeed-style quiz and then answering actually serious meta-cognitive questions.

Activities:

Activity	Materials
1. Instructor takes students through a slide deck with a “quiz” that reveals how open they are to considering new ideas or perspectives (too little, a reasonable amount—which is really all that’s needed—or so much they might be stressing themselves out).	• Slide deck
2. Students reflect on meta-cognitive questions (also in the slide deck) either in writing, in small groups, or in a whole-group discussion.
