# Welcome to Windows XP Epsilon Edition!

This document is about for documenting features, bugs, and changes for Windows XP Epsilon Edition.

## 1. What is Windows XP Epsilon Edition?

Windows XP Epsilon Edition is a spiritual successor of XP Delta Edition, as XP Delta is no longer updated too much. This project aims to make Windows XP SP3 (with Windows Embedded POSReady 2009 updates integrated) to function like Windows XP RTM, SP1 and maybe SP2. Not only focuses on making more like the original Windows XP RTM-SP1, but it also focuses in consistency fixes (resources reused from Windows XP Unity project), have Windows 9x upgrade support (except 95) (it uses Windows XP SP1 installer), adds forgotten executables which it can be found in other folders, stuff from release candidate builds and high quality sounds from build 2481. It's themed under default theme from Windows XP. It includes updates, fixes and patches from Windows XP Integral Edition.

### 2. Installation

## 2.1. Installing from CD

Installation is exactly the same as you install Windows XP. When you boot from the ISO, you can choose to install the OS, repair the install with a recovery console or either cancel installing if you don't want to install it. To begin the install, press Enter, you'll have to agree with license agreement, select your partition, you can create a new one with your specified size, or either begin with a single partition without creating any partitions, Windows will create a new partition for you. You can format in NTFS or FAT. If it was created before with format, you can choose to don't format, but you can choose to delete your old Windows folder or make a new Windows folder with a different name (not recommended). After partitioning and formatting page, Windows will check your hard drive and later, it will copy the files and configure the registry to boot into installation. After the first stage of setup, you will greet with Windows XP boot screen and later the full screen Setup window. After the devices are installed, you will greet with Regional and Language Options window. You can pick your user/system locale and keyboard layout, your name and organization, your Windows XP Professional VL key, your computer name and built-in administrator password, time and date, your timezone of your place where you live. After this step, it will install networking for you. You can pick typical settings or custom settings (if you want to install your networking components), then you can type your workgroup name. And you're done setting up.

## 2.2. Installing from Windows

Installing from Windows is a different process, if you run Windows 95 or later, you can install the operating system. Upgrading from Windows 95 isn't supported, you must upgrade to Windows 98 first if you want to keep your data and settings. Upgrading from Windows 98 (original release and Second Edition), 2000, Me, XP (original release, SP1, SP2 and SP3) are supported, you can keep your data and settings. If you changed your mind and don't want keep your data and settings, please opt for a clean install. Please follow the steps in screen. A Windows XP Professional VL product key is required to complete the upgrade/install. If you're running Windows Server 2003 or later, you can't install it due to being newer. You have to follow installing from CD instead.

## 2.3. Repair mode (recovery console)

Repair mode is a function included with any Windows install. It consists of a MS-DOS like console. To change the keyboard layout, press Enter. And if you're using a US keyboard, wait for some seconds. If a Windows install is detected, you can select a Windows install to repair, and later type your administrator password (if there's no password, you can leave it as blank). If there's no Windows install, then it will start the recovery console without selecting the operating system and typing an administrator password. To use the recovery console, you can do like you do in MS-DOS. To view a list available of commands, please type "help" (without quotes).

#### 3. Features

## 3.1. Windows Media Player

This mod contains Windows Media Player 8, which is from Windows XP RTM. On Windows XP SP2, Microsoft upgraded to Windows Media Player 9, according to Microsoft, this was done to fix security vulnerabilities which were not present in Windows Media Player 9 Series. To restore Windows Media Player 8 on Windows XP, Microsoft advised to uninstall Service Pack 2, or Service Pack 3 (if Service Pack 1 was installed before) for that operating system. But in this mod it restored Windows Media Player 8 in Windows XP Service Pack 3 and it works fine. It contains the missing skins from WMP8 which it wasn't installed by default in SP2 onwards.

## 3.2. Windows Movie Maker

Windows Movie Maker 1.1 is included, which it have a older interface than the one from Movie Maker 2.x. It looks simpler and doesn't have many features like effects and transitions.

#### 3.3. Address Toolbar

Address toolbar has been returned to this mod, thanks to browseui.dll from Windows XP SP2. It doesn't require to use Windows Desktop Search for this restoring feature. Windows XP SP3 removed Address toolbar in the taskbar due to legal reasons, but Windows Vista onwards (including Windows 11 with ExplorerPatcher or alternatives) are still included for unknown reasons. Windows Desktop Search is touted as a replacement, 3rd party tools are available to get similar functionality, but to restore this functionality, replace browseui.dll from Windows XP SP2.

#### 3.4. Display Properties

Display Properties have a bugfix which is a fatal flaw by Microsoft which it didn't change the Link Select cursor, it has been fixed by replacing from Link to Hand in a hex editor. On Screen Saver section, the missing Energy Star logo has been restored by replacing themeui.dll from SP2. Internet Explorer special desktop icon functionality has been restored thanks to 6.0.2900.3139 version of shell32.dll. This change has been done in KB943460 updates onwards and XP SP3. In fact, this is not a bug and is by design, probably due to anti-trust litigation settlement which requires Microsoft to disintegrate IE from operating system so that other web browsers can compete freely with IE6, IE7 or even IE8 in future (and they barely succeded to disintegrate IE, we got Microsoft Edge nowadays).

#### 3.5. Windows Messenger

This mod contains a old version from Windows Messenger from RTM version. It's not patched by default but I recommend to download Escargot if you want to use Messenger. Because sign in page design is different from SP2/SP3 one, but RTM have a different design.

#### 3.6. Sounds

New sounds are the same as Windows XP, but albeit in a higher quality and stereo. From build 2485, the sounds were compressed for some reason. Which is in mono (except Startup, Logon, Logoff, Shutdown) and 22050 hz. But in this mod, it contains stereo and 44100 hz sounds. title.wma have a higher quality and stereo version instead of default Windows XP one.

## 3.7. Upgrading

It uses Windows XP SP1 winnt32 files to fix issues with upgrading from Windows 98, 98 SE and Me to XP SP3. This has been done as SP3 contains a bug with upgrading from said versions. Windows NT 3.51 and old Whistler builds are supported.

## 3.8. Remote Desktop Connection

Remote Desktop Connection is from Windows XP SP2, and it's used to make authentic to the RTM/SP1/SP2 releases from Windows XP. SP3 contains Windows Vista SP1 Remote Desktop Connection, which it was upgraded, but in this mod, it's downgraded to the old version from XP SP2. And for this part, you can have multiple concurrent remote desktop connections within this mod.

#### 3.9. UX Theme

This mod contains a patched version of UX Theme. It lets you to use any themes which aren't officially signed by Microsoft. You can use any custom theme with it, downloading from 3rd-party websites or themes made by users or by yourself.

#### 3.10. Sound Recorder

Sound Recorder has been fixed to support in computers that have more than 2 GB of RAM, and you can record more than 60 seconds (1 minute, meaning you have 999 seconds (16 minutes, 39 seconds estimated time) to record your audio.

## **3.11. Non-standard floppy formats**

Now this mod allows to use non-standard floppy formats. This hasn't been documented yet, but flyydisk.sys has been patched to have this.

## 3.12. Win16 SubSystem

Win16 subsystem has been patched so there will be no concern while using 16-bit apps complaining for insufficient resources even you have more RAM.

### 3.13. Program shortcuts

This mod have shortcuts for programs which aren't added by Microsoft. This includes: NetMeeting, ClipBook Viewer, IExpress Wizard, Object Packager, Private Character Editor, Program Manager, Chat, DDE Share, and RTC App Sharing.

#### 3.14. Program Manager

On Windows XP SP1, it was the last version to have a working Program Manager, and later turned into a stub in XP SP2. But now it's back into XP SP3. It contains the familiar Windows 3.x style interface to open programs, like a Start Menu. You can create groups and items whenever you like.

#### 3.15. Boot Screen

The bootscreen has been updated to look like the one from Windows XP RTM/SP1. It contains the edition name and copyright year. But this change is artificial, and it's the edition name and copyright year in a single bitmap. Edition name was using a separated bitmap in RTM and SP2 only.
