How the Bail Process Works

When someone is arrested, they're processed into the jail system—fingerprinted, photographed, and checked for outstanding warrants. Once this is complete, a bail amount is set. At this point, you have options:

- 1. Pay the full bail amount directly to the court: This requires certified funds, but the entire amount will be returned when the case concludes.
- 2. **Use a bail bondsman**: For a non-refundable fee (typically 10% of the bail amount), a bail bonds company like Angels will post the full bond with the court.

As part of the process, someone must sign as an indemnitor for the defendant, guaranteeing both their court appearances and accepting financial responsibility if they fail to appear.

DUI and Alcohol-Related Arrests

If your loved one has been arrested for DUI or another alcohol-related offense in Huntington Beach, they will typically be held for 6-8 hours before they can be released, regardless of bail status. Our agents understand these special circumstances and can guide you through the process.
