Keeping us informed



Please continue to keep us informed if your child, or anyone in your house tests positive for coronavirus. To do this please send an email to admin@st-fidelis.bexley.sch.uk with the subject line: URGENT - Positive Coronavirus Case. If you suspect a case of coronavirus in the household, it is recommended that you test the whole family. This is to stop the delay between testing parents and then children a few days later, so in school we can start the contact tracing sooner.

AT HOME BEFORE SCHOOL



This leaflet is designed to explain how families and staff can help us to make this return to school safe and successful for all of our children.



Do not come to school if **anyone** in your home is displaying possible symptoms of coronavirus. This is a high temperature, a loss of taste or smell, or a new, continuous cough. **Feeling unwell means staying at home.**



Check everyone's temperature either using a thermometer or hand- do they feel hot to the touch or unusually cold. If unsure keep the whole family at home.



Check that everyone coming to school, adults and children, has washed their hands just before leaving home, ensuring all parts of the hands are covered.



Arrive at the agreed time. Once the school day has started late arrivals will not be admitted as the hygiene entry system will not be operating.

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION



This leaflet is designed to explain how families and staff can help us to make this return to school safe and successful for all of our children.



Do not bring children to school if anyone in your home is displaying possible symptoms of coronavirus. This is a high temperature or a new, continuous cough.



Families should arrange for children to arrive between 8:30am and 8:55am.



Families will queue separately on either sides of the main pathway until the gates are opened.



Children will sanitize their hands at a cleaning station before entering the playground.



Families should arrange for children to be collected at the following times:

3:00pm Nursery & Reception 3:10pm Year 1 and Year 2 3:20pm Years 3, 4, 5 and 6



Adults should stay 2m away from each other wherever possible. Staff will not be able to meet with parents and communication should be by phone or email whenever possible.



Adults should wear a mask at collection time to protect themselves and others.



Children should stay close to their families and leave the school on the left hand side of the main pathway. Only one adult per family should come into the school at the end of the day.




Excellent learners






Wow, look at these sentences which this Reception Child has written. I am very impressed at your punctuation.
