This summer FCCLA (Family, Career, Community Leaders of America) had four students from LHS compete at the FCCLA National Leadership Conference in Seattle. Emily Gull received a Silver medal and Ash Mead and Lillian Cook received a bronze medal. Marlie Hernandez placed 8th nationally and was awarded a gold medal. Of the seven other students to place in the top ten nationally from Wyoming, only Marlie and one other student received a gold medal for their project.
